### Day 2:- Larnaca city tour

### Day 3:- Larnaca - TROODOS - KYKKOS AND KAKOPETRIA - MOUNTAIN VILLAGES

Experience the best vantage point atop Throni Hill, where you'll find the tomb of revered political and religious leader Archbishop Makarios III, accompanied by a panoramic highland view. Enjoy lunch at a traditional tavern before delving into Cyprus's rich winemaking history, dating back almost 6000 years. Explore a vineyard, learning the secrets of cultivating vines and making exquisite wines, sampling both young and mature varieties like Xynisteri, and savoring the boldness and rich structures of red wines. Return to Larnaca and overnight at the hotel

## Day 4:- Larnaca - KOURION OLD TOWN - PAPHOS CITY TOUR

## Day 5:- Larnaca - Nicosia city tour

Witness the historic Venetian walls and Famagusta Gate, bearing witness to the city's events since the 16th century. Visit the Archbishop's Palace, home to an impressive collection of religious icons, and traverse Eleftheria Square. Cross the border into Northern Cyprus, where you'll discover original Christian and Muslim places of worship, including the 11th-century Cathedral of St. John the Theologian and the Selimiye Mosque (formerly Cathedral of Saint Sophia). Enjoy a traditional tavern lunch before strolling through the old city's winding streets, exploring traditional houses, craft shops, and popular cafes and restaurants, immersing yourself in the diverse cultural richness of both parts of Nicosia. Return to Larnaca and overnight at the hotel

## Day 6:- Larnaca - Famagusta

Breakfast at the hotel. Delve into the transformation of Famagusta, a historically rich neighborhood altered by the development of the Turkish Cypriot Republic. Commence your journey at Othello Castle, a 14th-century marvel where Shakespeare's famous play comes to life. Explore the Lala Mustafa Pasha Mosque, a 13th-century Gothic example marked by war, disasters, and religious conversion. Uncover the ancient city-state of Salamis, witnessing its diverse history through occupations by Phoenicians, Assyrians, Greeks, Persians, Macedonians, Romans, and Ottomans since the 11th century BC. Visit Saint Barnabas Monastery, dating back to the 5th century, now hosting museums abandoned after the change to Turkish Cypriot rule. Conclude the tour in Varosha, a once-popular tourist destination turned ghost city since 1974, where luminaries like Elizabeth Taylor and Richard Burton frequented. Wrap up the day with a relaxing beach visit, enjoying a refreshing swim in the warm turquoise waters of Cyprus. Return to Larnaca and overnight at the hotel
