## Day 3 :- Lima - Cusco - Sacred Valley

Quechua scholar Nilda Callañaupa Alvarez shares the history and culture of traditional Peruvian Cusqueñan textile weavers at the Center for Traditional Textiles of Cusco in the heart of the Sacred Valley.

## Day 4 :- Sacred Valley

## Day 5 :- Sacred Valley - Ollantaytambo - Machu Picchu

Learn the art of tea making at a working tea plantation or view the world's largest private collection of indigenous orchids.

## Day 6 :- Machu Picchu
