

# Day 1 :- Welcome to Zagreb

Embark on an epic discovery of the Balkans. Croatia's capital city of Zagreb is your springboard to a fascinating journey through wh once a troubled region and is today a land of diverse cultures and traditions which you will have a unique opportunity to enjoy with newfound friends.
