Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Changsha - Fenghuang

Upon arrival, meet the tour guide and transfer to **Changde** (2 hours). Visit **Liu Ye Lake**, a scenic freshwater lake, and the **Poem Wall**, showcasing local poetry and culture.

Continue to Fenghuang (2 hours) and explore Phoenix Ancient Town, known for its 400-year-old architecture. Visit Tuo Jiang River, Diaojiaolou Stilted Buildings, North Gate Tower, Stone Floor Street, and Bar Street. Enjoy a night tour before checking in to the hotel.

Day 2 :- Fenhuang - Zhangjiajie

After breakfast, travel to Furong Ancient Town (2 hours) for a cruise, battery car ride, and a visit to the waterfall . Then, transfer to Zhangjiajie (2 hours) and explore Tujia Minority Folk Park to experience Tujia culture. Stop for an exterior view of the 72 Floors of Mystery, then check in to the hotel.

Breakfast Lunch

Day 3 :- Zhangjiajie

After breakfast, visit **Tianmen Mountain Scenic Area**, including **cable cars**, **eco-vehicles**, **escalators**, **Tianmen Cave**, **and glass walkways**, and enjoy breathtaking views and cultural sites. In winter, some areas may be closed. Also, visit the **Military Decree Art Institute**, then return to the hotel.

*Note: During winter, the red sections are closed. Also, visit the Military Decree Art Institute.

Breakfast Lunch

Day 4 :- Zhangjiajie

After breakfast, take the **Hundred Dragons Sky Ladder** to **Yuanjiajie** and explore **Avatar Mountain**, the **Number One Bridge in the World**, and the **Enchanting Platform**. Continue to **Tianzi Mountain** for stunning views at **Yubi Feng** and **Xianren Scattering Flowers**. Visit **Helong Park**, then descend by **Tianzi Mountain cable car**.

Breakfast Lunch

Day 5 :- Zhangjiajie

After breakfast, visit **Zhangjiajie National Forest Park**, part of the **Wulingyuan Scenic Area**. Explore **Golden Whip Stream**, a scenic trail with unique rock formations and wildlife, then continue to the **Ten-Mile Gallery** for breathtaking mountain views and a **small train ride**. Return to the hotel.

Day 6 :- Zhangjiajie - Changsha

After breakfast, visit **Zhangjiajie Grand Canyon**, home to the world's **longest and highest glass bridge**, offering breathtaking views of forests, waterfalls, and streams. Then, transfer to **Changsha** by bus (4 hours) and check in to the hotel.

Day 7: Departure Changsha

After breakfast, visit **Juzizhou (Orange Isle)**, a scenic island in the **Xiang River** and a national AAAAA tourist attraction. Enjoy shopping at **Huangxing Walking Street**, then transfer to the airport for your flight back to **Malaysia**.
