The tour continues by minibus to the city center, passing through Castel Nuovo (Maschio Angioino) and stopping at the terrace of the church of S. Antonio in the Posillipo area for a stunning panoramic view of the gulf. The tour concludes in the city center with visits to Piazza del Plebiscito, the splendid Umberto I Gallery, and the exteriors of the Royal Palace and the S. Carlo Theatre. End your day with an overnight stay in Naples.
