Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Rome

Upon arrival at Rome airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. After checking in and settling into your hotel, the remainder of the day is yours to explore at your leisure.

Day 2 :- Rome : Vatican Museums and Imperial Rome with Colosseum

Begin the day with breakfast at the hotel before transferring to the starting point of the tour. Start with a visit to the Vatican Museums, including the Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica. Day 4 :- Florence walking tour with Accademia Museum

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before embarking on a guided walking tour of Florence. Explore the city's historic center, visiting key landmarks such as the iconic Duomo Cathedral, Piazza della Signoria with its Palazzo Vecchio, the Baptistery and its "Gates of Paradise," Giotto's Bell Tower, and Brunelleschi's Dome. After the walking tour, skip the lines at the Accademia Gallery to see Michelangelo's renowned Statue of David, along with his unfinished sculptures, Prigioni and San Matteo. The gallery also features works by Botticelli, Uccello, and del Sarto, which your guide will help you discover. Overnight stay in Florence.

Breakfast

Day 5 :- Florence : Pisa excursion

Start the day with breakfast at the hotel before departing for a small group excursion to Pisa. Visit the renowned Leaning Tower and the beautiful Piazza dei Miracoli, one of the world's most stunning monumental complexes. Discover Pisa's rich history, including its significant period in the 12th century and its role as a major naval base during Roman times. Explore the Cathedral's interior and the exterior of the Leaning Tower and Monumental Cemetery with a local guide. Enjoy free time to explore the square and take photographs before returning to Florence for an overnight stay.

Day 6 :- Florence - Venice

Breakfast in hotel. Departure to Venice via highspeed train. Arrival in Venice and check-in at hotel. Free time at leisure. Overnight in Venice.

Day 7 :- Venice City Tour

Begin your day with a hearty breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, join a shared walking excursion (SIC) of Venice (entrance fees not included). This tour provides a unique exploration of Venice, starting with a walking tour that uncovers the city's hidden gems and picturesque spots around St. Mark's Square. Highlights of the walking tour include: St. Mark's Square: Admire the grandeur of St. Mark's Basilica, the elegant Doge's Palace, the Clock Tower, and the Procuratie (exterior views only). Campo Santa Maria Formosa: Discover this charming square and visit the Scuola Grande di San Marco, known as the "Great School of Charity." Malibran Theatre and the Mercerie: Stroll through this historic shopping district, once central to Venice's commercial life, connecting Rialto Bridge and St. Mark's Square. The second part of your tour features a scenic gondola ride through Venice's enchanting canals. Learn about the gondola's history and symbolism, including its multi-pronged ferro (prow) representing the six sestieri (districts) of Venice and its S-shape echoing the flow of the Canal Grande. Enjoy the captivating beauty of Venice from the water, with a gondola ride accommodating up to five people, guided by a local gondolier in a distinctive blue and white striped shirt. Board assistance is provided, but please note there is no commentary during the ride. End your day immersed in the magic of Venice. Overnight stay in Venice.

Begin your final day in Venice with a delicious breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, transfer to Venice International Airport for your departure.
