Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Tbilisi

Upon arrival in Tbilisi , the tour guide will meet you at the Airport. Transfer to the hotel, check in and overnight

Day 2 :- Tbilisi – Gori – Uplistsikhe – Borjomi - Bakuriani

Breakfast at the hotel. Later, meet the guide in the lobby, and start the tour exploring Gori City. Visit the Stalin Museum, which houses over 60,000 artifacts, Stalin's birthplace, and a bulletproof train he used. Next, explore the ancient cave town of Uplistsikhe with its unique rock-cut architecture. Enjoy a local lunch nearby. Drive to Borjomi, take a walk in Central Park known for its mineral water, and ride the cable car in the mountains. Finally, head to Bakuriani for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 3 :- Bakuriani – Vardzia – Akhatiskhe – Rabati Castle – Bakuriani

Breakfast at the hotel, then drive to Vardzia—a remarkable cave complex with over 600 rooms, including monasteries, temples, fortresses, baths, libraries, and residential buildings. Extending along the mountain for 800 meters, reaching depths of up to 50 meters, and standing eight floors high, Vardzia served both as a defensive fortress and a Christian monastery, centered around the Church of the Assumption of the Virgin. After exploring Vardzia, continue to Akhaltsikhe, known as the “New Fortress,” situated on the banks of the Potskhovi River at an altitude of 1000 meters. Visit the recently restored Rabati Fortress, a military structure dating back to the 13th century. Return to Bakuriani for dinner and overnight stay

Day 4 :- Bakuriani – Ananuri – Gudauri – Kazbegi

Start your day with breakfast at hotel. Begin your journey by driving to the Ananuri complex, a former residence of Argveti Dukes, known for its churches and towers dating back to the 16-17th centuries. Enjoy the beautiful view of the Jinvali reservoir from the complex. Continue your drive to Gudauri, a mountain ski resort situated on the southern slopes of the Caucasus Mountains at an altitude of 2000 meters. Visit the Friendship Monument near Gudauri, also known as Gudauri Panorama or Treaty of Georgievsk Monument, built by the Soviet Union to commemorate the 200 years since the signing of the Treaty of Georgievsk in 1783. Admire the Soviet-style mosaics depicting Georgian and Russian heroes, farmers, fairy tales, and communist symbols. Afterward, proceed to Kazbegi, check into the hotel, and enjoy dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 5 :- Kazbegi – Gergeti Trinity Church – Mtskheta – Jvari – Tbilisi

Begin your day with breakfast. Drive to the Gergeti Trinity Church, renowned as one of the world's most beautiful churches, nestled amid magical landscapes. Built in the 14th century, this cross-cupola church in Khevi province remains unaltered in its architecture and serves as an active establishment of the Georgian Orthodox and Apostolic Church.

As you journey through the Caucasus, learn about the mythical ties to Prometheus, the Titan chained to the icy slopes of Kazbegi in Georgian stories. Visit Mtskheta, one of Georgia's oldest cities and the former capital of the Georgian Kingdom of Iberia. Explore the Svetitskhoveli Cathedral, dating back to the 11th century and recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage site, known for housing the burial site of Christ's mantle.

Continue your exploration with a visit to the Jvari Monastery, a 6th-century Georgian Orthodox monastery near Mtskheta, also designated as a World Heritage site. En route to Tbilisi, make a stop at the Chronicles of Georgia monument, a creation by Zurab Tsereteli that stands 30 meters tall, depicting the history of Georgia and scenes from the life of Jesus Christ.

Upon reaching Tbilisi, check in at the hotel for some rest. Later in the evening, enjoy dinner at a traditional Georgian restaurant featuring a lively Georgian Dancing Show.

Day 6 :- Depart Tbilisi

Start your day with breakfast. Embark on a Tbilisi city tour, beginning at Metekhi Church and the monument to Vakhtang Gorgasali, the legendary founder of Tbilisi. Explore Narikala Fortress to enjoy a breathtaking panoramic view of the city. Stroll past Tbilisi's only mosque, heading down to the sulphur bathhouse district. Wander through the Sharden area, characterized by narrow streets with cozy cafés, wine bars, and souvenir shops, immersing yourself in the history of Old Tbilisi.

Visit significant landmarks such as Sioni Cathedral, Anchiskhati Basilica, and the renowned Rezo Gabriadze Theatre's clock tower. Cross the Bridge of Peace to reach Rike Park. After the city tour, drive to the airport for your departure home.
