Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Amman

Meet and greet upon arrival at Amman International Airport. Transfer to your hotel and check-in. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to relax or explore the city at your own pace.

Dinner

Day 2 :- Amman City Tour

Start the day with a guided tour of Amman, exploring its rich history and vibrant culture. Visit the Roman Theater, the Citadel, the Archaeology and Folklore Museum, and take in the contrast between old and modern Amman. Conclude the tour with a visit to one of the city's renowned art galleries. Spend the afternoon at leisure before enjoying a delightful dinner at a local restaurant.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 3 :- Amman - Dead Sea & Northern Jordan Exploration - Amman

Drive down to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth, and enjoy the unique experience of floating in its mineral-rich waters. Continue north to Pella, an ancient city in the Jordan Valley with fascinating archaeological remains. Next, visit Um Qais (Gadara), known for its biblical significance, and take in breathtaking views of the Sea of Galilee, the Yarmouk River, and the Golan Heights. Return to Amman in the late afternoon.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 4 :- Amman – Jerash – Ajloun - Amman

Enjoy a late morning tour of Jerash (Gerasa of antiquity), the best-preserved city of Roman times, to visit its theaters, temples, churches, and colonnaded streets. Then continue to Ajloun to tour the 12th-century Saracen Castle built by one of Saladin's lieutenants in the campaign against the Crusaders. Afterward, have dinner.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 5 :- Amman - Petra

Embark on a scenic journey along the historic King's Way, making stops at some of Jordan's most significant sites. Visit Madaba, home to the world-famous Byzantine mosaic map of the Holy Land and the renowned Mosaic School. Continue to Mt. Nebo, the legendary site where Moses is believed to have seen the Promised Land, offering breathtaking views over the Dead Sea and the Jordan Valley.

Drive through the dramatic landscape of Wadi Mujib, a stunning canyon known as Jordan's 'Grand Canyon.' Arrive in Kerak to explore its imposing Crusader Castle, a masterpiece of medieval military architecture (Optional Lunch Stop)

Proceed to Petra, where you will check in and spend the night, preparing for an unforgettable exploration of the Rose-Red City the next day

Breakfast Dinner

Day 6 :- Petra

Spend a full day uncovering the wonders of Petra, the ancient Nabatean city carved into the rose-red Siyah Mountains. Hidden for centuries, Petra was rediscovered by Swiss explorer Johann Ludwig Burckhardt in the 19th century.

Begin your journey with a walk through the Siq, a narrow and winding canyon that leads dramatically to Al-Khazneh (The Treasury), Petra's most iconic monument. Continue exploring its vast archaeological treasures, including the Roman Theater, the Royal Courts, Qasr Bint Pharaoun, and the Temple of the Winged Lion.

Enjoy an optional lunch break, or for the adventurous, embark on a climb up to Ad-Deir (The Monastery), one of Petra's largest and most breathtaking structures. (additional charges apply).

After a day of exploration, return to your hotel in Petra for an overnight stay.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 7 :- Petra - Depart Amman

Begin the day with a visit to the breathtaking Wadi Rum Desert, a vast and otherworldly landscape often described as the “Valley of the Moon.” Explore its dramatic rock formations, sweeping sand dunes, and ancient petroglyphs, made famous by the film “Lawrence of Arabia.”

After the desert experience, proceed to Amman for your departure flight or continue to the Araba Crossing for border formalities.

Alternatively, for those looking to extend their journey, head to Aqaba for a relaxing stay by the Red Sea, where you can enjoy pristine beaches, water activities, and vibrant marine life. If you wish to extend your stay in Aqaba, contact us for available options and arrangements.
