## Day 1 :- Arrive Swiss Border - Lucerne

Arrive in Lucerne by train and discover one of Switzerland's most picturesque cities. ## Day 2 :- Lucerne : Titlis - Eternal Snow and Glacier

Embark on a breathtaking alpine journey from Lucerne to Engelberg, where the Titlis Xpress aerial cable car takes you into a world of snow and ice. Marvel at the stunning glacier crevasses and towering ice formations as you ascend in the Rotair, the world's first revolving cable car.

At Mt. Titlis (3,028m a.s.l.), immerse yourself in a high-altitude paradise with panoramic views of the Swiss Alps. Savor an authentic Swiss meal at a mountaintop restaurant before exploring the Glacier Cave, a mesmerizing tunnel of eternal ice. Dare to cross Europe's highest suspension bridge, the Cliff Walk, and glide over deep crevasses on the Ice Flyer chair lift. For an extra thrill, try snowtubing at Glacier Park, an exhilarating experience year-round. Descend via cable car to Engelberg and return to Lucerne by coach.

## Day 3 :- Lucerne - Lugano

Start your day with breakfast at the hotel before embarking on an unforgettable journey aboard the Gotthard Panorama Express, linking the scenic landscapes of Central Switzerland with the Mediterranean charm of Ticino.

Your adventure begins in Lucerne, where you board a historic steamer for a 2.5-hour cruise across Lake Lucerne. Glide past tranquil bays and picturesque villages as you take in the breathtaking alpine views. Upon arrival in Flüelen, continue your journey by train through the dramatic Reuss Valley, passing deep ravines and towering cliffs.

Experience the legendary Gotthard route, climbing from 470m to 1,100m before entering the 15-km-long Gotthard Tunnel, Switzerland's iconic north-south gateway. Emerging on the other side, you'll find yourself in Ticino, where a warm Mediterranean climate and Italian flair await. As the train winds through the scenic Leventina Valley, admire its breathtaking bridges and charming villages before reaching Bellinzona, where you change trains for the final stretch to Lugano.

Enjoy an overnight stay in Lugano, Switzerland's southern jewel, known for its stunning lakeside setting and Italian-inspired atmosphere.
