Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrival Hanoi - Halong

Upon arrival at Noi Bai International airport, our representative will meet and transfer to Hanoi downtown to visit Hoan Kiem Lake (Restored Sword Lake), St Joseph's Cathedral, shopping at 36 Old Quarter, dinner and overnight in Hanoi.

Dinner

Day 2 :- Halong – Hanoi

After breakfast, transfer to Halong boat station to take our private boat to visit the world Heritage Halong Bay about 4 hours, our boat will bring us to visit Paradise Grotto, Kissing Chicken Rock, Fisherman Village, lunch will be served with fresh Halong Seafood, enjoy Vietnam Coffee on Cruise. Transfer back to Hanoi, dinner at local Restaurant, overnight in Hanoi.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 3 :- Hanoi – Lao Cai – Cat Cat Village - Sapa

Breakfast at hotel, transfer to Sapa (It takes around 5 hours for transferring by bus). Arrival sapa at middle day. After lunch, following the road down to the valley by steps, walking to H'Mong Village (Cat Cat Village) working on the paddy fields and their animals, such as Chicken, Water Buffaloes and pot Bellied pigs. You can also see the old Hydro Electric Power Station which was built by the French time in early 20th century, and a beautiful waterfall that is the good place for resting. Back to Sapa town to visit the busy market where Red Dao, Black & Flower H'Mong, Tay and other ethnic minority people converge from the surrounding countryside to sell their silverware and handicrafts, and to buy provisions, continue to visit Sapa French Church, Dinner & overnight in Sapa.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 4 :- Sapa – Fansipan Peak – Rong May Glass Bridge

Breakfast at hotel, visit Fansipan Mountain by the cable car. As you know the cable car in Sapa is the world's longest and highest cable car, running up from sleepy Sapa Town in Lao Cai Province to the peak of 3,143-meter Fansipan Mountain, known as Indochina's rooftop. Enjoy the view from the highest point of this incredible mountain. The lush green and subtropical vegetation makes this mountain really very beautiful. Take some pictures for unforgettable experience from the top. After taking scenery then get cable car back to Sapa. In the afternoon, transfer to visit Rong May Glass Bridge which means Dragon in Cloud Glass Bridge, you will enjoy the stunning view from the height of more than 2000m above sea level with the terraced fields, green tea fields, rolling hills and mountains, spectacular cloud yards. Dinner and overnight in Sapa.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 5 :- Sapa - Hanoi

Breakfast at hotel, transfer back Hanoi. After lunch, visit the West Lake, Tran Quoc Pagoda, Hoan Kiem Lake (Restored Sword Lake) and shopping at 36 Old Quarter, dinner and overnight in Hanoi.

Day 6 :- Depart Hanoi

After breakfast, free at leisure. Check out hotel. Our driver will transfer to Hanoi airport for departure flight back to Malaysia.
