Day 4 :- TROY AREA-PERGAMUM-KUSADASI

Trojan War TROY Enjoy a guided visit. PERGAMUM Guided visit of the Asklepon, a shrine to the Greek God of medicine. (B,D) 267 mi / 430 km TOUR HIGHLIGHT HEALING THE BODY & THE SOUL Nestled between hills, the Asklepon retains a sense of serenity and history. The sick approached the temple via the Sacred Way, a path that started their journey to health determined according to what dreams the patient experienced and which also included theatre shows.
