Tour Itinerary

DAY 1:- PARIS

Arrive in Paris. Paris, the capital of France, is a significant European metropolis as well as a global center for art, fashion, food, and culture. Wide boulevards and the Seine River cut through its 19th-century cityscape. Aside from the Eiffel Tower and the Gothic Notre-Dame cathedral from the 12th century, the city is known for its cafe culture and designer stores along the Rue du Faubourg Saint-Honoré. Private transfer to your hotel. Free at your own leisure.

Overnight in Paris.

DAY 2:- PARIS

Breakfast at hotel. Enjoy a meal on the second floor of the Eiffel Tower, a city tour by covered panoramic bus and a one-hour cruise on the Seine. A one-and-a-half-hour panoramic bus tour to discover Paris, its history and major monuments, with audio-guided commentary (individual headphones). From the foot of the Eiffel Tower, embark on a fantastic one-hour audio cruise on the Seine. Spend a pleasant moment on the terrace or in the fully glazed boat, and let yourself be carried away by this river cruise from bridge to bridge, escorted by Parisians on foot and by bike. Then enjoy an excellent lunch on the Eiffel Tower's second floor. Discover Thierry Marx's cuisine, defined by local and responsible products. Return back to hotel.

DAY 3:- PARIS

Breakfast at hotel. Continue to Loire Valley. Escape the hustle and bustle of Parisian life and enter into the Garden of France. Stroll the walkways of the French monarchs, hear tales of royal love affairs and kidnappings, and behold the beauty of the Loire Valley's exquisite Chateaux. The first stop of the day is Château de Chambord. Next up is the charming Château de Chenonceau, a true fairy tale castle set picturesquely on the Cher River. The site of the first-ever French fireworks display, Chenonceau is really one to fall in love with. The last stop will be at Château de Cheverny, a 17th-century beauty furnished in great taste and with marvelous gardens. Enjoy free time for lunch (not included) during the day either at Chenonceau or Chambord. You'll be back in Paris in the evening.

DAY 4:- PARIS - BRUSSELS

Breakfast at hotel. Free & Easy until depart for Brussels by train. The City of Brussels is the largest municipality and historical center of the Brussels-Capital Region, as well as the Flemish Region's and Belgium's capital. The European Quarter in Brussels houses a number of major Europe organizations, making it the administrative center of the European Union. Upon your arrival, make your own way to the hotel. Free at your own leisure.

DAY 5:- BRUSSELS

Breakfast at hotel. Meet your guide in the center of Brussels and relax on the 100-kilometer journey to Bruges by bus. Upon arrival, discover the charms of "the Venice of the North". Marvel at highlights such as the Lake of Love (Minnewater Lake) and the 13th-century Begijnhof complex. Go to Walplein Square, where the shady trees and cafes provide a perfect place to relax. Visit Stoofstraat on the site of the city's former Red Light District. Go to one of the city's most photographed spots at Rozenhoedkaai, and admire the Belfry on Castle Square. Visit Market Square (Grote Markt). Then enjoy 1-hour's free time for lunch (at your own expense). Next, drive to Ghent. Take a guided tour of the city's historic buildings where you can learn about the painting of "The Adoration of the Mystic Lamb" by the Van Eyck brothers. Admire the Belfort (Bell Tower) and peculiar Gothic and Renaissance-style Town Hall. Enjoy some free time in this magical city before returning back to Brussels.

DAY 6:- BRUSSELS - AMSTERDAM

Breakfast at hotel. Free & Easy until depart for Amsterdam by train. Amsterdam is the capital of the Netherlands, famous for its cultural history, elaborate canal system, and narrow buildings with gabled facades, all of which are remnants of the city's 17th-century Golden Age. Its Museum District is home to the Van Gogh Museum, the Rijksmuseum, and the Stedelijk. Cycling is integral to the character of the city, and there are numerous bike trails. Upon your arrival, make your own way to the hotel. Free at your own leisure.

DAY 9:- AMSTERDAM - FRANKFURT

Breakfast at hotel. Free & Easy until depart for Frankfurt by train. Frankfurt, a city in central Germany on the Main River, is a major financial center and home to the European Central Bank. It is the birthplace of the famous writer Johann Wolfgang von Goethe, whose former residence is now the Goethe House Museum. It, like much of the city, was destroyed during WWII and later rebuilt. Römerberg, a square in the reconstructed Altstadt, is the location of an annual Christmas market. Upon your arrival, make your own way to the hotel. Free at your own leisure.

DAY 10:- FRANKFURT

Breakfast at hotel. Enjoy a guided day tour to the beautiful city of Heidelberg, and discover why this historical city on the Neckar is visited by millions of visitors from all over the world every year. Start your tour by visiting the famous Heidelberg Castle. Learn about the castle's structure, its courtyard, ruins, and construction. Enjoy a wonderful view of the city from the castle's huge terrace, and look at one of the largest wine barrels in the world. After visiting the castle, walk through the medieval center to the old bridge and the Karlstor, the Renaissance house to the knight, and the Heiliggeistkirche. Learn about the city's history from your local quide.

Located in northern Switzerland at the north end of Lake Zurich, is the city of Zurich, a major hub for banking and finance worldwide. The 17th-century Rathaus (town hall) is located along riverfront promenades such as the Limmatquai. Upon your arrival, make your own way to the hotel. Free at your own leisure.
