Tour Itinerary

Day 1:- Arrival Swiss Border - Davos

Individual travel to Davos. The town in the mountains – made famous by the yearly WEF when world and economic leaders meet in Mid-January, offers countless winter activities from ice-skating, over cross country skiing and sledging to off piste skiing and snowshoeing. If time allows explore the town and surrounding winter walking trails in the afternoon. Overnight in Davos.

Day 2 :- Davos @ Horse Drawn Sleigh Ride

Breakfast at your hotel. Explore the highest-town in Europe further. Browse the many art galleries, cafés, and shops or head for the winter sports areas surrounding Davos. In the early afternoon enjoy a 1-hour horse-drawn sleigh ride in one of the magical valleys nearby. In the unlikely event of insufficient snow down in the valley the sleigh will be replaced with a horse-drawn carriage ride. Overnight in Davos.

Day 3:- Davos - Filisur (Glacier Express) - Brig - Montreux

Breakfast at your hotel. Take a regional train from Davos to Filisur. Board the Glacier Express, whilst it may not be the quickest route it certainly is the most scenic with breath-taking views alongthe way. Change at Brig for onward train connections to Montreux. Add a meal on the Glacier Express (suppl. applies). Overnight in Montreux.

Day 4 :- Montreux (GoldenPass) - Gstaad - (Glacier 3000) - Gstaad - Montreux

Breakfast at your hotel. Travel by Golden Pass train to the chalet village of Gstaad. Well known for its vast ski area the picture postcard winter sports resort is equally attractive to non-skiers, with it beautiful panoramic setting amidst the pristine alpine winter scenery. Continue by bus for the short journey to the valley station of Glacier 3000 for some some snowy adventures at 3,000m. In the late aftern return via Gstaad back to Montreux. Overnight in Montreux.

Day 5 :- Montreux - Bern

Breakfast at your hotel. In the morning take time to explore Montreux with its serene lakeside promenade. In the afternoon transfer to Bern, Switzerland's capital. Easily explored on foot, the city centre feels like a step back in time with its cobbled streets, water fountains and 15th century buildings. Be sure to visit one of the cellar restaurants for an atmospheric dining experience. Overnight in Bern.

Day 6 :- Bern - Murren - Allmendhubel Murren - Bern

Breakfast at your hotel. In the morning transfer by train via Interlaken Ost and to Lauterbrunnen. From here take the Gondola to Grütschalp and a short train ride on to the car free ski resort of Mürren. The picture postcard chalet-style resort offers a breathtaking view across the Lauterbrunnen Valley towards Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau mountains. A short ride by funicular takes you to the top of Allmendhubel with its beautiful winter walking and sledging trails as well as the panorama restaurant with sun terrace. Late afternoon return to Bern.

Day 7:- Bern - Lucerne

Breakfast at your hotel. Morning departure to Lucerne. One of the most popular destinations in Switzerland, Lucerne in winter time is a magical place. Surrounded by snow capped mountains and a glistening lake. The old town is similarly charming and the Chapel Bridge is a highlight. Overnight in Lucenre.
