### Tour Itinerary

#### Day 1 :- Arrival in Baku.

Arrive in Baku airport. Transfer to hotel.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

#### Day 2 :- Baku City & Absheron Peninsula.

Explore Icheri Sheher (Old City), a UNESCO-listed historical center featuring Maiden Tower, Shirvanshahs' Palace, and Caravanserai. Visit Martyrs' Lane, a memorial with stunning views of the Baku coastline. Stroll along Nizami Street and Fountain Square, and see the futuristic Heydar Aliyev Center (exterior). Overnight in Baku.

#### Day 3 :- Baku – Shamakhi – Sheki.

Depart for Sheki, stopping at Diri Baba Mausoleum, a mystical 15th-century tomb built into a cliff. Visit Juma Mosque, one of Azerbaijan's oldest mosques. In Sheki, explore the Palace of the Sheki Khans, famous for its stained-glass windows, and visit the local caravanserai and handicrafts workshops. Overnight in Sheki.

## **Day 4 :- Azerbaijan / Georgia border – Kakheti Province – Tbilisi.**

Cross into Georgia and visit Khareba Winery, an underground wine cellar carved into rock, for a wine tasting. Explore Signaghi, a charming town with 23 watchtowers and stunning views of the Alazani Valley. Visit Bodbe Convent, the burial site of St. Nino, Georgia's patron saint. Continue to Tbilisi. Overnight in Tbilisi.

## **Day 5 :- Tbilisi City Tour**

Explore Metekhi Church, overlooking the Mtkvari River, and Narikala Fortress, offering panoramic views. Walk through the sulfur bath district and Sharden Street, lined with cafés and wine bars. Visit Sioni Cathedral, Anchiskhati Basilica, and the Rezo Gabriadze Theatre Clock Tower. Cross the Bridge of Peace and take a funicular ride for a scenic city view. Overnight in Tbilisi.

## **Day 6 :- Tbilisi – Mtskheta – Kazbegi**

Visit Jvari Monastery, a 6th-century church with breathtaking views of the Aragvi and Mtkvari rivers. Continue to Svetitskhoveli Cathedral, Georgia's second-largest church, believed to house Christ's robe. Stop at Ananuri Fortress, overlooking the Jinvali Reservoir. Drive through the Cross Pass, stopping at the Soviet-era Friendship Monument. In Kazbegi, visit Gergeti Trinity Church, set at 2,170m with stunning views of Mount Kazbek. Overnight in Kazbegi.

## **Day 7 :- Kazbegi – Gori – Uplistsikhe – Tbilisi**

Explore Uplistsikhe, an ancient rock-hewn town dating back to the Hellenistic period. Visit Stalin Museum in Gori, featuring his childhood home and bulletproof train. Stop at the Chronicles of Georgia, a massive monument depicting Georgian history. Return to Tbilisi. Overnight in Tbilisi.

## **Day 8 :- Tbilisi – Georgia/Armenia Border – Haghpat – Sevan – Yerevan**

Cross into Armenia and visit Haghpat Monastery (UNESCO site), a 10th-century architectural masterpiece overlooking the Debed River. Continue to Lake Sevan, one of the world's largest high-altitude lakes, and visit Sevanavank Monastery, perched on the lake's peninsula. Arrive in Yerevan, Armenia's capital. Overnight in Yerevan

## **Day 9 :- Yerevan – Garni – Geghard – Yerevan City Tour**

Explore Garni Temple, the only surviving Greco-Roman structure in Armenia. Visit the Geghard Monastery (UNESCO), carved into cliffs. In Yerevan, see Republic Square, Cascade Complex, home to the Cafesjian Center for Arts, Northern Avenue, and the Opera House. Overnight in Yerevan.

## **Day 10 :- Yerevan – Khor Virap – Noravank – Etchmiadzin**

Visit Khor Virap Monastery, where St. Gregory the Illuminator was imprisoned, offering stunning views of Mount Ararat. Explore Noravank Monastery, surrounded by red cliffs. Discover Areni Cave, site of the world's oldest known winery. Visit Etchmiadzin Cathedral, the spiritual center of the Armenian Apostolic Church, and Zvartnots ruins before returning to Yerevan. Overnight in Yerevan.
