Day 7 :- Samarkand, Uzbekistan

Today, explore the historic city of Samarkand, once considered the most beautiful and important city under Timur's rule. Visit the but town of Shah-i-Zinda, the Afrasiyab excavation sites (with a museum tour), and the iconic Registan Square, surrounded by three gramadrasas with stunning portals and glittering mosque domes. In 1917, Uzbek women symbolically burned their face veils here. You stay two nights in a mid-range hotel.

Day 8 :- Samarkand

Today, you visit a silk carpet manufactory and a Uzbek artisan family that makes paper from mulberry tree bark, you will see the Ulu Beg Observatory and the ruins of the Bibi-Khanym Mosque. The palace-like Gur-i-Amir mausoleum complex can be visited from the inside. It houses the tomb of Timur, who made his capital a paradise as a famous builder, but also went down in history as a feared conqueror.
