Day 1 :- ARRIVE IN TORONTO, ONTARIO

Then, tour Canada's only walled city with a Local Guide. Until the British victory of 1759, Old Quebec was the centre of New France. Within its walls are Place d'Armes, Laval Seminary, and ancient Place Royale. Also, see the old-world houses crowding the narrow streets in Lower Town by the St. Lawrence River and historic Plains of Abraham. The afternoon is free to explore the historic sites or stroll the streets of Old Quebec City. Your Tour Director will have suggestions for additional sightseeing, shopping, and dining. This evening, consider an optional dinner that includes a visit to 274-foot-high Montmorency Falls and dinner at Le Moulin de Saint-Laurent – a restored 17th-century flour mill.

Day 8 :- QUEBEC CITY-MONTREAL

Magical Montreal On to Montreal, where sightseeing with a Local Guide includes Notre Dame Basilica, the Old Seminary of St. Sulpice, and a drive to the top of Mount Royal to enjoy a panorama of the city.
