## Day 7:- LEIPZIG - WEIMAR - COBURG - NUREMBERG.

Leave Leipzig to visit Weimar, home to many intellectuals of the past but mainly known for the name given to the historical period of "Weimar Republic." This city is also famed as the home of the Bauhaus architectural movement in the 1920s. Next stop is Coburg. Very the dominating and mighty Veste Coburg Castle, built in 1225. Today, the castle houses the former art collections of the dukes of Continue to Nuremberg for a visit to its town centre, dominated by the imperial castle.

## Day 8:- NUREMBERG - ROTHENBURG - MUNICH.
