Day 6 :- ZADAR – KRKA – TROGIR – SPLIT AREA

Head into central Dalmatia and visit Krka National Park, renowned for its breathtaking waterfalls and attractive water mills. Join your Local Guide to explore the outstanding natural beauty. The park is home to more than 200 species of birds; be sure to watch for osprey, golden eagles, peregrine falcons, and Eurasian eagle-owls. Visit Trogir with its medieval walls, seaside promenade, and maze-like marble streets. Continue to the vibrant port city of Split.

The guided tour of Split reveals a city whose splendour dates back to the 4th century when Emperor Diocletian built his phenomenal palace-now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Later, take advantage of the exciting optional excursion.
