Day 1 :- ARRIVAL COLOMBO – NEGOMBO

Arrive in Sri Lanka. Meet and assist on arrival at airport by local representative. Then transfer to hotel for check in and overnight in Negombo.

Day 2 :- NEGOMBO - MAWANELLA - KANDY

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Nuwara Eliya and continue tour to visit places as follows:

Spice Gardens in Mawanella is a popular attraction located in the central province of Sri Lanka. The gardens showcase a vast variety of spices and herbs that are used in traditional Sri Lankan cuisine, such as cinnamon, cardamom, vanilla, and cloves.

The Temple of the Tooth, also known as Sri Dalada Maligawa, is a revered Buddhist temple located in the city of Kandy, Sri Lanka. The temple houses the sacred tooth relic of the Buddha, making it one of the most sacred pilgrimage sites for Buddhists around the world.

The Kandy Cultural Show is a vibrant and colorful display of traditional Sri Lankan dance and music that takes place in the city of Kandy. Day 3 :- KANDY - NUWARA ELIYA

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Nuwara Eliya and continue tour to visit places as follows:

Ramboda Falls is a spectacular waterfall located in the central province of Sri Lanka, situated between the towns of Pussellawa and Nuwara Eliya. It is one of the highest waterfalls in the country, with a height of approximately 109 meters (358 feet), and is fed by the Panna Oya river. The falls are surrounded by lush greenery and steep rock faces, making for a dramatic and awe-inspiring sight.

Nuwara Eliya is famous for its high-quality tea, which is grown in the surrounding hills and is an integral part of the city's culture and economy. The tea plantations in Nuwara Eliya are situated at an altitude of over 6,000 feet and benefit from the cool climate and fertile soil, resulting in tea with a distinct flavor and aroma.

Ambuluwawa mountain peak has a height of 3567 feet above sea level. It is located over 1000 feet above from the Gampola Town. The tower is located on the summit of the mountain peak. Since there are no other mountains in the surrounding area and due to its unique location, Ambuluwawa Tower gets an undisturbed view from far away and vice versa. The tower is visible from Gampola Train Station.

Nuwara Eliya is a picturesque city located in the central highlands of Sri Lanka. Often referred to as "Little England", it is known for its climate, tea plantations, and colonial architecture. The city's lush green hills and valleys provide a stunning backdrop for a range of outdoor activities, such as hiking, cycling, and horse riding.

Then, transfer to hotel for check in and overnight in Nuwara Eliya.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 4 :- NUWARA ELIYA - GALLE - BENTOTA

Breakfast at hotel. After that, transfer to Galle. Explore the Galle Fort, is a historic coastal city located in the southwestern part of Sri Lanka. The city is famous for its well-preserved Dutch colonial architecture, which is evident in its fortifications, buildings, and narrow streets. The old town of Galle is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is home to various cultural attractions, such as the Galle Fort, the Reformed Church, and the Maritime Museum.

Stilt fishing is a traditional method of fishing used by the people living in the southern coastal areas of Sri Lanka. The practice involves fishermen sitting on a vertical pole, locally known as a "petta," which is planted into the shallow waters of the sea. They balance themselves on the petta, holding a fishing rod with one hand and using the other hand to catch the fish. This unique fishing technique has become a popular attraction for tourists visiting Sri Lanka, who are interested in learning about the traditional way of life of the Sri Lankan coastal communities.

Then, transfer to hotel for check in and overnight in Bentota.

Day 5 :- BENTOTA - COLOMBO

Breakfast at hotel. Continue tour with a Boat Safari at Madhu River:

Madu River Ride – Enjoy a scenic cruise along the Madu River, a relaxing trip with plenty of interesting stops. You pass dozens of islands forested with mangroves and can appreciate the timeless natural rhythms of rural life. You cruise in canopies, outboard motors power boats, en route take in the view of a 200-year-old temple and watch the local’s cultivating cinnamon.

Turtle Hatchery in Sri Lanka has a couple of places on the island which are synonymous for turtle hatchery and conservation. These places are a special treat if you are an animal enthusiast. The coastal area of the island is where you should head to witness a turtle hatchery -where turtle eggs are being hatched and small and rescued turtles are being taken care of.

Then, transfer to hotel for check in and overnight in Colombo.

Day 6 :- COLOMBO – AIRPORT

Gangaramaya Temple is a significant Buddhist temple located in the heart of Colombo, Sri Lanka.
