Day 1 :- ARRIVAL COLOMBO – KANDY

Arrive in Sri Lanka. Meet and assist on arrival at airport by local representative. Then transfer to Kandy and continue tour to visit places as follows:

Spice Gardens in Mawanella is a popular attraction located in the central province of Sri Lanka. The gardens showcase a vast variety of spices and herbs that are used in traditional Sri Lankan cuisine, such as cinnamon, cardamom, vanilla, and cloves.

The Temple of the Tooth, also known as Sri Dalada Maligawa, is a revered Buddhist temple located in the city of Kandy, Sri Lanka. The temple houses the sacred tooth relic of the Buddha, making it one of the most sacred pilgrimage sites for Buddhists around the world.

The Kandy Cultural Show is a vibrant and colorful display of traditional Sri Lankan dance and music that takes place in the city of Kandy. The show features talented dancers and musicians performing various cultural art forms, including fire-dancing, drumming, and acrobatics. The performances are a fusion of different Sri Lankan cultures, representing the rich heritage of the island.

Then, transfer to hotel for check in and overnight in Kandy.

Lunch Dinner

Day 2 :- KANDY - NUWARA ELIYA

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Nuwara Eliya and continue tour to visit places as follows:

Ramboda Falls is a spectacular waterfall located in the central province of Sri Lanka, situated between the towns of Pussellawa and Nuwara Eliya. It is one of the highest waterfalls in the country, with a height of approximately 109 meters (358 feet), and is fed by the Panna Oya river. The falls are surrounded by lush greenery and steep rock faces, making for a dramatic and awe-inspiring sight.

Sri Bhaktha Hanuman Temple: According to the legend, this is where Hanuman searched for Sita in the jungles above and behind the temple. There is also said to be a pond – the 'Sita Tear Pond' – here, which was formed from Sita's tears. The temple itself is one of the more enterprising establishments devoted to this legend and contains a granite statue of Lord Hanuman that is said to be over 40 feet tall.

Nuwara Eliya is famous for its high-quality tea, which is grown in the surrounding hills and is an integral part of the city's culture and economy. The tea plantations in Nuwara Eliya are situated at an altitude of over 6,000 feet and benefit from the cool climate and fertile soil, resulting in tea with a distinct flavor and aroma.

Then, transfer to hotel for check in and overnight in Nuwara Eliya.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 3 :- NUWARA ELIYA - KATARAGAMA

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Kataragama and continue tour to visit places as follows:

Seetha Amman temple the stream that runs from the hill, catered to the needs of Sitadevi during her stay at Ashok Vatika. She is said to have bathed in this stream. About a century ago of three idols was discovered in the stream, one of which was that of Sita. It is believed that the idols have been worshipped at this spot for centuries. Now there is temple for Lord Rama, Sitadevi, Luxshmana, and Hanuman by the side of this stream.

Visit Murugan Temple. Kataragama a popular pilgrimage destination frequented by adherents of all religions in Sri Lanka. The main shrine devoted to Skanda popularly described in eulogies as God having six faces and twelve arms whose assistance is sought for worldly gain. The history of the shrine dates to 2 century BC. The annual procession held in July or August is the main event of the shrine with fire walkers and Kawadi dancers.

Then, transfer to hotel for check in and overnight in Kataragama.

Day 4 :- KATARAGAMA - GALLE - COLOMBO

Yala National Park is a vast wildlife sanctuary located in the southeastern part of Sri Lanka, known for its incredible biodiversity and stunning landscapes. The park is home to a wide range of animals, including leopards, elephants, crocodiles, and a variety of bird species. Visitors can explore the park on guided jeep safaris, which offer the opportunity to see the animals in their natural habitat.

After that, transfer to Galle. Explore the Galle Fort, is a historic coastal city located in the southwestern part of Sri Lanka. The city is famous for its well-preserved Dutch colonial architecture, which is evident in its fortifications, buildings, and narrow streets. The old town of Galle is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is home to various cultural attractions, such as the Galle Fort, Dutch Reformed Church, and the Maritime Museum.

Stilt fishing is a traditional method of fishing used by the people living in the southern coastal areas of Sri Lanka. The practice involves fishermen sitting on a vertical pole, locally known as a "petta," which is planted into the shallow waters of the sea. They balance themselves on the petta, holding a fishing rod with one hand and using the other hand to catch the fish. This unique fishing technique has become a popular attraction for tourists visiting Sri Lanka, who are interested in learning about the traditional way of life of the Sri Lankan coastal communities.

One of its most striking features is a beautiful Bo tree, which is said to have been grown from a sapling of the tree under which the Buddha attained enlightenment.
