Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Vientiane

Upon arrival at the airport, transfer to hotel for check-in. After check-in, free at own leisure for the rest of the day.

Day 2 :- Vientiane

- Wat Sisaket the oldest temple to have been survived from the Siamese war of 1828 and its cloister contains more than 8000 Buddha statues, antiques and all artifacts found in around Vientiane
- That Luang Stupa the single most important monument in Laos, which was built to cover the original small stupa containing a chest bone of Buddha
- Patouxay (Arch de Triumph) built quite recently in commemoration of those who died during the wars in the past and it is today a land-mark of Vientiane
- Taladsao Central Market It's known for its wide variety of goods, including traditional Lao textiles, handicrafts, jewelry, electronic goods and everyday household items.
- Buddha Park also known as Xieng Khuan, is a famous sculpture park located about 25 kilometers southeast of Vientiane, Laos

Breakfast Lunch

Day 3 :- Vientiane – Kunming

After breakfast, transfer to the train station and take the train to Kunming station (About 10 hours). Arrival at Kunming Station, meet and transfer to the hotel for check-in

Day 4 :- Kunming - Chuxiong

- Shilin Scenic Area – The Stone Forest has the most unique karst landform in the world due to its long history, large scale, and variety. It's reputed as "First Wonder under the Heaven" and enjoys a high reputation in world geography circles.

Day 5 :- Chuxiong - Dali

- Yunnan Dali Santorini – It is a unique style of buildings, built near the Erhai Lake, looking down as if leaning against Cangshan Mountain, there are many beautiful homestays inside, known as the Oriental Santorini Town. (Optional add on teatime : RM 50 per person)
- Xizhou Ancient Town – With a history of more than 1000 years, is located at 18 km north of Dali Old Town, west leaning on Cangshan Mountain, Erhai Lake in the east.
- Three course tea of Bai Ethnic – Three-course tea ceremony is a must try thing in Xizhou. Three-course tea, first cup is bitter, second cup is sweet and the third cup is for aftertaste, which indicating the pursuit of perfection of personality during the whole life.
- Dali Ancient Town + Yangren Street – Dali Old Town has historic sites, ancient buildings, temples, and streets lined with shops, restaurants, bars, and hotels.

Breakfast

Day 6 :- Dali – Shangri La

- Shaxi Ancient Town – Shaxi Old Town is a true ancient town that remains the most original architectural style. The ancient temples, stages, ancient stores and ancient alleys seem to bring travelers to the ancient time.
- Tiger Leaping Gorge (Not include escalator)- called Hutiao Xia in Chinese, located at the border of Lijiang and Shangri-La, is a scenic spot on the Jinsha River, a primary tributary of the upper Yangtze River.
- Dukezong Ancient Town – A Tibetan town in Shangri-la country
- Guishan Park – Guishan park is built against the mountain, which is the commanding height of the ancient city. The park consists of Prayer Wheel, Dafo Temple (Chaoyanglou), Red Army Long March Museum, Diqing History Museum, etc.

Breakfast

Day 7 :- Shangri La – Lijiang

- Shangri-La Songzanlin Monastery – Also known as Ganden Sumtseling Monastery, it is the largest Tibetan Buddhist monastery in Yunnan Province, often referred to as “Little Potala Palace” due to its architectural similarity to the Potala Palace in Lhasa, Tibet. It’s an important religious and cultural site.
- Lijiang Ancient Town – The Old Town of Lijiang, which is perfectly adapted to the uneven topography of this key commercial area, has retained a historic townscape of high quality and authenticity.
- Sifang Street – The Square Street is lined with numerous stores. Four main streets radiates from Square Street and extending in different directions.

Breakfast

Day 8 :- Lijiang

- Lijiang Glacier Park (Included ropeway, hybrid car) – It is one of the first national 5A tourists attraction in China, with an area of 130 kilometers and a maximum elevation of 5,596 meters, it is more than 20 kilometers away from the Old Town of Lijiang, a world heritage site
- Ganhaizi Sea Meadow – It had been a highland glacial lake before the 1940s and was formed after the water had dried up. It is located on the east foot of Jade Dragon Snow Mountain and is only 25 kilometers (15.5 miles) away from Lijiang Old Town.
- Baishui River – Known for its clear, milky white water that flows through a series of small, cascading terraces.
- Bluemoon Valley – A beautiful valley with turquoise-blue lakes, stunning waterfalls, and lush greenery.
- Impression Lijiang Performance – Impression Lijiang is a magnificent outdoor singing and dancing performance demonstrating the traditions and lifestyle of the local ethnic people

Day 9 :- Lijiang – Kunming

- Lijiang to Kunming by High Speed Train (about 3.5 hours)
- Jingxing Flower Street + Pedestrian Street + The Moon Building
- Transfer to the hotel for check-in, free at your own leisure

Day 10 :- Departure Kunming

- Daguan Tower – It is a historical landmark and tourist attraction located in Daguan Park on the northern shore Dianchi Lake in Kunming
- Dounan Flower Market – Asia’s largest flower market in China
- Transfer to Kunming airport for your departure flight
