Day 3:- Larnaca - Lefkara - Larnaca

In Lefkara, indulge in fresh lokum (Turkish delight) and explore buildings crafted from local stone. Visit the 14th-century Holy Cross Church to see a piece of the True Cross, and learn the history of the Halloumi cheese, a Cypriot favorite, from its origins to modern-day recipes. Conclude your tour by sampling homemade Halloumi, guided by an experienced cook who will teach you the traditional methods of preparing this beloved cheese, offering a true taste of Cyprus.

Day 3 :- Larnaca - Troodos - Larnaca

After a hearty breakfast at the hotel, embark on a journey through the centuries-old villages, breathtaking nature, and medieval monasteries of the Troodos Mountains. Begin with a walk through Omodos Village, where you'll explore the cobbled streets and visit the Holy Cross Monastery, Cyprus's oldest, with its charming arched galleries and stone walls. Continue to Kykkos Monastery, dedicated to the Virgin Mary, home to a revered icon believed to work miracles. The monastery offers stunning mountain views, and the nearby Throni Hill peak provides the best vantage point on the island. Here, visit the tomb of Archbishop Makarios III, a significant religious and political leader, while enjoying a breathtaking highland panorama. The island's wine tradition, nearly 6,000 years old, thrives in this region. At a local vineyard, you'll learn the secrets of cultivating vines and crafting exquisite wines, shaped by the warm climate and high-altitude vineyards. Enjoy the boldness and rich flavors of Cypriot red wines as you delve into the island's unique wine heritage, with exports reaching far and wide, from the USA to Europe. This tour blends history, nature, and culinary delights, offering an unforgettable experience of Cyprus's cultural and natural treasures.

Day 4 :- Larnaca - Paphos - Larnaca

After breakfast at the hotel, delve into ancient history by exploring the archaeological wonders of Paphos. Begin at the Rock of Aphrodite, a massive limestone believed to be the birthplace of the goddess of love, widely revered in Cyprus. Continue to the UNESCO-listed Paphos Archaeological Park (Nea Paphos), where remnants of early Greek and Roman civilizations await. Marvel at the stunning Roman villa mosaics and visit the Tomb of the Kings, where 100 Ptolemaic aristocrats were laid to rest. Next, explore the Paphos Castle, bearing the marks of various rulers, from Byzantines to Ottomans. The journey then takes you to the revered site of St. Paul's Pillar, where legend says the Saint was whipped for preaching Christianity. The site also features the Agia Kyriaki Church and Agia Solomoni Church, both steeped in religious significance. Day 5 :- Larnaca - Nicosia - Larnaca

Day 6:- Larnaca - Northern Cyprus - Larnaca
