## Day 1 :- ARRIVAL CHITOSE (CHITOSE AIRPORT)-ASAHIKAWA

- Asahikawa Ramen Village – is a collection of eight popular shops that serve Asahikawa-style ramen, one of the unique ramen varieties created in Hokkaido.
- Asahiyama Zoo – is a municipal zoo that opened in July 1967 in Asahikawa, Hokkaido, Japan, and is the northernmost zoo in the country.
- Ginga Waterfall – There are waterfalls in Sounkyo from Japan's Top 100 Waterfalls.
- Sounkyo Hyobaku Festival – is known as one of the best winter activities in Hokkaido. There are about 30 ice sculptures of various sizes on a 10,000-square-meter site beside the Ishikari River.

## Day 3 :- ABASHIRI – AKAN

- Sea Of Okhotsk Drift Ice – Drift ice begins to form in the waters near the mouth of the Amur River, north of Sakhalin Island, around mid-November.
- Mount Iwo – also Mount Iwo is an active andesitic stratovolcano on the Shiretoko Peninsula of Hokkaido, Japan.
- Lake Mashu – is an endorheic crater lake formed in the caldera of a potentially active volcano.
- Tsurumidai – Popular birding spot on a sprawling plain & winter feeding ground for Japanese red-crowned cranes.

## Day 4 :- AKAN – SAPPORO

- Kofuku Eki – is a closed railway station on the defunct Hiroo Line in Obihiro, Hokkaido, Japan.
- Hokkaido Jingu – named the Sapporo Shrine until 1964, is a Shinto shrine located in Sapporo, Hokkaido, Japan.
- Tokeidai (Sapporo Clock Tower) – is a wooden structure and tourist attraction located at North 1 West 2, Chuo-ku, Sapporo, the largest city on the island of Hokkaido, Japan.
- Odori Park – is a park located in the heart of Sapporo, Hokkaido, Japan. Odori means “large street” in Japanese.
- Sapporo Tanukikoji Shopping Street – is an approximately 1km-long arcade with around 200 shops that runs east to west in downtown Sapporo.

- Hokkaido Old Government Office – The facilities of the former Hokkaido Government Office in Sapporo, Japan, include a conference room, a museum shop, a tourist information office, and a few historical exhibition rooms and libraries.
- Shiroyo Koibito Park – is a theme park by Ishiya, a local chocolate company.
- Otaru Musicbox Museum – has more than 3400 types of music boxes and it's the largest specialty shop in Japan.
- Kitaichi Glass – is one of the most popular brands based in Otaru, established in 1901 as a manufacturer of petrol lamps and trawler floats.
- Otaru Canal – The Otaru Canal is a popular tourist destination for Japanese and foreign visitors who flock to the canal year round to enjoy its nostalgic atmosphere.
