## Day 1:- Arrive Incheon - Chuncheon - Seoul

After breakfast, start your day at Gamcheon Culture Village, an artistic neighborhood known for its colorful houses, street art, and charming alleyways. Proceed to Yongdusan Park, a scenic park offering great views of the city. Visit Busan Tower within the park for a 360-degree view of Busan. Continue your exploration along Gwangbok-ro Fashion Street, a bustling area filled with fashion boutiques, cafes, and street performances. Head to BIFF Square, named after the Busan International Film Festival, for a variety of street food and entertainment. Conclude your day at Jagalchi Market, Korea's largest seafood market, where you can experience the lively atmosphere and sample fresh seafood.

## Day 4:- Busan - Seoul

After breakfast, take the KTX Train to Seoul. Upon arrival, visit Gyeongbokgung Palace, the largest of the Five Grand Palaces built during the Joseon Dynasty. Next, explore Bukchon Hanok Village, where you can wander through narrow alleys lined with traditional Korean houses, known as Hanoks. Conclude your trip with some shopping at Lotte Duty Free and then head to Myeongdong Market, a vibrant area known for its numerous shops, street food vendors, and lively atmosphere.
