### Tour Itinerary

## Day 1 :- Arrive Incheon - Chuncheon – Seoul

Meeting with our representative at Incheon airport upon arrival, after greeting transfer to visit Nami Island. After continue to Soyonggang Skywalk and explore Dongdaemun Design Plaza. Transfer back to the hotel for check-in.

## Day 2 :- Seoul - Busan

Conclude your day with a ride on the Haeundae Blue Line Park Beach Train (one way), enjoying the coastal views.

Head to BIFF Square, named after the Busan International Film Festival, for a variety of street food and entertainment. Conclude your day at Jagalchi Market, Korea's largest seafood market, where you can experience the lively atmosphere and sample fresh seafood.

## Day 4 :- Busan - Seoul

After breakfast, take the KTX Train to Seoul. Upon arrival, visit Gyeongbokgung Palace, the largest of the Five Grand Palaces built during the Joseon Dynasty. Then, visit HiKR Ground, a cultural and entertainment space that showcases Korean lifestyle and trends. Conclude your day with a relaxing stroll along Cheonggyecheon Stream, a scenic urban stream running through downtown Seoul.

Next, visit Gwangjang Market, one of Korea's oldest traditional markets, famous for its street food and textiles. End your trip with some shopping at Lotte Duty Free, followed by exploring Myeongdong Market, a bustling area with numerous shops, street food vendors, and a vibrant atmosphere.
