Day 1 :- Arrive in Honolulu

Once the home of Hawaiian royalty, Honolulu welcomes visitors from around the world to explore this tropical paradise.

Day 2 :- Honolulu, Excursion to Pearl Harbor

Heroes of the Sea This morning, meet your Tour Director and travel companions for breakfast and a welcome meeting. Next, head out on a guided sightseeing tour that includes Pearl Harbor, the USS Arizona Memorial and Museum, the Punchbowl National Cemetery, Chinatown, the Hawaii State Capitol, 'Iolani Palace, and Kamehameha the Great statue. Tonight, enjoy an included dinner at your hotel. (B,D) TOUR HIGHLIGHT SACRED SITE Visit the National Memorial and learn about one of the most pivotal moments U.S. history. Travel over to the USS Arizona Memorial and pay your respects to the 1,177 crewmen that were killed here on December 7, 1941. To this day, over 900 crewmen are entombed in the ship's wreckage 40 feet below the water here. You will also have an opportunity to visit the USS Arizona Memorial museum, an excellent way to learn about Pearl Harbor Day, the Japanese strategy and military craft, and the individuals involved in the attack.

Day 3 :- Honolulu

Take the optional excursion to the Polynesian Cultural Centre for authentic island arts, crafts, history, music, a dinner buffet, and a spectacular Polynesian show with more than 100 performers. Day 4 :- Honolulu - Hilo - Hawaii Volcanoes National Park - Na'Alehu - Kona

Polynesian Pleasures Board a morning flight to the "Big Island" of Hawaii. Upon arrival in Hilo on the east coast, drive to Hawaii Volcanoes National Park. Here, see Kilauea Crater, rising 4,090 feet above a volcanic wonderland of steaming fire pits, lava tubes, and fern forests. Next, enjoy an included lunch followed by a stop at Punalu'u Bake Shop to sample the famous Hawaiian malasada introduced to the islands by Portuguese sugar workers in the 19th century. In 1952, the grandson of Portuguese immigrants from the Azores Islands, Leonard Rego, opened a bakery and was the first to use island fresh eggs to make them golden brown on the outside and light and fluffy on the inside. The bakery has grown in popularity and is a must try when on the Hawai'i!

Day 5 :- Kona, Excursion to Coffee Farm & Luau

Feasts & Fire This morning, visit the Kona Coffee Living History Farm. Tonight, join your Tour Director for a festive luau.
