Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Auckland - Coromandel Peninsula

Upon arrival, you need to take a shuttle to the Britz Depot to collect the campervan. Next, you can explore Auckland City. Auckland New Zealand's largest city, situated between two harbours with gentle sandy shores on the east coast and black sand, wild surf beaches on the west coast. Home to sheltered, sparkling blue waters dotted with beautiful emerald islands, we recommend getting out on the water while you are here. You will then drive approximately 2.5 hours to Coromandel Peninsula. Overnight at Coromandel Top 10 Holiday Park.

Day 2 :- Coromandel Peninsula - Matamata - Rotorua

Today drive through the rolling green hills to Matamata (approx. 2 hours) the iconic Hobbiton Movie Set. See where the Lord of the Rings and Hobbit movies were filmed as your tour guide shares behind the scenes tales. You'll visit sights such as Hobbit Holes, the Mill, and The Green Dragon Inn, and learn how farmland was transformed into a living, breathing piece of Middle earth. After exploring Hobbiton you may enjoy a delicious lunch in the Party Marquee before continuing to Rotorua approx. (1 hour). Rotorua is surrounded by a fascinating geothermal landscape with its unique steam vents, spouting geysers and bubbling mud pools set alongside freshwater lakes and majestic native forests. It is also a region immersed in fascinating Maori mythology legends. Overnight at Rotorua Top 10 Holiday Park.

Day 3 :- Rotorua

Begin your day by visiting Wai O Tapu Thermal Wonderland, one of Rotorua's most vibrant geothermal areas. This natural wonderland is known for its strikingly colorful geothermal features. After exploring Wai O Tapu, head to Hell's Gate Geothermal Park & Mud Spa. This unique geothermal reserve is home to bubbling mud pools, hot springs, and the largest hot water lake in the Southern Hemisphere. Explore geothermal parks and experience Maori cultural activities, including the Te Puia experience, the dinner, and a Haka dance. Overnight stay at Rotorua Top 10 Holiday Park.

Optional activities:

Wai O Tapu: NZD \$45 per adult / NZD\$15 per child

Day 4 :- Rotorua - Taupo

You may begin your day with a peaceful walk through the Redwoods, Whakarewarewa Forest. The towering redwood trees create a serene atmosphere, perfect for a morning stroll. Heading to Taupo (approx. 1 hour), a picturesque town on the shores of Lake Taupo. The drive is scenic, with views of rolling hills and distant mountains. The lake was formed by a super volcanic eruption around 26,500 years ago. Enjoy a lakeside walk, or simply relax and take in the serene views of the water with the backdrop of Mount Ruapehu in the distance. You may visit Huka Falls, a stunning natural attraction known for its powerful and dramatic waterfall. The falls are a great spot for photos and a quick stretch. Overnight at Taupo DeBretts Spa Resort.

Day 5 :- Taupo - Napier

Drive to Napier (approx. 2 hours), the route takes you through scenic landscapes, including stretches of beautiful countryside and rolling hills. Napier is famous for its extensive collection of Art Deco architecture, a result of the city being rebuilt after a devastating earthquake in 1931. As you arrive in Napier, you may take a self-guided stroll through the city center to admire the beautifully preserved buildings with their vibrant pastel colors, geometric shapes, and ornate details. This walk will give you a sense of the city's unique charm and history. Overnight at Napier Top 10 Holiday Park

Day 6 :- Napier - Gisborne

Leave Napier and drive to Gisborne (approx. 2.5 hours), you will travel along the Pacific Coast Highway, a route known for its stunning coastal views and lush landscapes. About halfway to Gisborne, you may find Morere Hot Springs, a hidden gem set amidst a beautiful rainforest. These natural hot pools offer a peaceful setting to relax and rejuvenate after your drive. Upon arrival in Gisborne, you'll be greeted by a laid-back town known for its beautiful beaches, rich Maori culture, and excellent wineries. End your day by heading to Wainui Beach, located just a short drive from central Gisborne. This beach is known for its stunning sunsets and is a popular spot for both locals and visitors. Overnight at Gisborne Top 10 Holiday Park

Day 7 :- Gisborne - Auckland Departure
