Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Christchurch - Lake Tekapo

Upon arrival, you need to take a shuttle to the Britz Depot to collect the campervan. Next, you can explore Christchurch . Christchurch is set between the deep blue Pacific Ocean and the mighty snow capped Southern Alps. This is a vibrant, ever changing city with inner city parks and gardens delightfully interwoven by the meandering Avon River. Drive to Lake Tekapo (approx. 3 hours), you have great opportunity to enjoy the scenic views Upon arriving in Lake Tekapo , you'll be greeted by the breathtaking sight of the turquoise water of the lake, framed by the surrounding mountains. Visit the iconic Church of the Good Shepherd, one of the most photographed spots in New Zealand. This small stone church was built in 1935 as a memorial to the pioneers of the Mackenzie region. Overnight at Lake Tekapo Holiday Park.

Day 2 :- Lake Tekapo - Mount Cook

Drive to Mount Cook , New Zealand's highest peak approx. 1.5 hours), the route takes you through some of the most scenic landscapes in the South Island. As you approach Mount Cook, you'll drive along the shores of Lake Pukaki, another glacial lake renowned for its striking turquoise color. Upon arrival at the National Park , a haven for nature lovers and adventure seekers, with numerous walking tracks, wildlife, and stunning alpine landscapes. You may take optional Scenic Helicopter Flight which offers a unique perspective of the rugged terrain and pristine glaciers, with some tours even landing on the Tasman Glacier. Overnight at Glentanner Park Centre.

Optional activities: Scenic Helicopter Flight Includes Mountain Landing (25mins): NZD\$330 per person

Day 3 :- Mount Cook - Queenstown

You can wake up early to catch the sunrise over Aoraki/Mount Cook. The first light hitting the peak of New Zealand's highest mountain is a spectacular sight. After that, begin your journey towards Queenstown (approx. 3 hours). As you drive away from Mount Cook National Park, the landscape gradually shifts from alpine terrain to rolling hills and farmlands. Upon arriving in Queenstown, known as the adventure capital of New Zealand, offering a wide range of activities and experiences. You can explore the town or join some optional adventure activities in Queenstown. Overnight at Queenstown Holiday Park & Motel Creeksyde.

Day 4 :- Queenstown - Te Anau

Depart for Te Anau (approx. 2 hours), the gateway to Fiordland National Park. The drive takes you through some of New Zealand's beautiful landscapes, with rolling hills, crystal clear rivers, and expansive farmlands. Along the way, take the opportunity to stop and enjoy the scenery. One notable stop is the Kingston Flyer, a historic railway site, where you can stretch your legs and take in the views of Lake Wakatipu and the surrounding mountains. Arrive in the picturesque town of Te Anau, located on the shores of Lake Te Anau, the largest lake in the South Island. Overnight at Te Anau Top 10 Holiday Park.

Day 5 :- Te Anau - Milford Sound - Te Anau

Begin your drive to Milford Sound (approx. 2 hours), one of New Zealand's most iconic natural wonders. The route from Te Anau to Milford Sound, known as the Milford Road, is one of the most scenic drives in the world, winding through the heart of Fiordland National Park. You may make a brief stop at Mirror Lakes, located about 30 minutes from Te Anau. These small lakes perfectly reflect the surrounding mountains on calm days, offering stunning photo opportunities. Upon arriving at Milford Sound, embark on a scenic cruise to fully experience the beauty of this fiord. Cruises typically last around 1.5 to 2 hours and take you past towering cliffs, cascading waterfalls, and lush rainforest. Drive back to Te Anau, the return journey offers another chance to appreciate the incredible landscapes, with afternoon light casting a different glow over the scenery. Overnight at Te Anau Top 10 Holiday Park.

Day 6 :- Te Anau - Dunedin

Begin your journey towards Dunedin (approx. 4 hours), a city rich in Scottish heritage and known for its historic architecture and vibrant wildlife. Arrive in Dunedin in the early afternoon. Dunedin is known for its well-preserved Victorian and Edwardian architecture, steep streets, and rich cultural history. The city's Scottish heritage is evident in its buildings, street names, and even its local traditions. Start your exploration of Dunedin in the city center. Highlights include the Dunedin Railway Station, often regarded as one of the most beautiful railway stations in the world, and the Octagon, an eight-sided plaza that forms the heart of the city. Overnight at Dunedin Holiday Park.

Day 7 :- Dunedin - Christchurch

Depart for Christchurch (approx. 4.5 hours), the drive will take you through the scenic Otago and Canterbury regions, passing through charming towns and rolling countryside. You may stop in Timaru for lunch. This coastal town offers a range of dining options, from cafes to waterfront restaurants.

Besides, you can have a brief stop in Geraldine, a charming rural town known for its artisan shops, local produce, and beautiful gardens. Upon arrival in Christchurch, you can explore the "Garden City". Overnight at Christchurch Top 10 Holiday Park.

Day 8 :- Christchurch Departure

Depending on the time of your flight, you may have a bit of time to explore more of the city or relax before your departure. If you have some free time in the morning, take a ride on the Christchurch Tram. This historic tramway loops through the city center, providing a relaxing and informative way to see some of Christchurch's key attractions. Return your campervan and prepare for your departure. From Christchurch, you can catch your flight back to your homeland, concluding your New Zealand adventure.
