Day 1 :- EMBARKATION - Istanbul, Turkey

Day 3 :- Ephesus (Kusadasi), Turkey

Europe's classical metropolis, Ephesus, was one of the largest cities in all of the Roman Empire, boasting one of the Seven Wonders of the World, the Temple of Artemis. Explore the ruins of its massive Theater, the Temple of Hadrian and the magnificent Celsus Library.

Day 4 :- Mykonos, Greece

Steeped in Greek mythological history, Mykonos was named after Apollo's grandson, Mykons, and was the location of the grand battles of Zeus and the Gigantes. Today, this island is one of Greece's most adored destinations due to its picture-postcard setting and growing Mykonos is a superb example of Cycladic architecture, and by law even new buildings have to be built in the same style of whitewashed cube-like buildings. Be sure to plan a day trip to take in picturesque Little Venice, the unique Paraportiani church, and the archeological site of Delos.

Day 5 :- Katakolon, Greece

Step back in time at Ancient Olympia, the birthplace of the Olympic Games – now deemed a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Relive the cheers of the spectators as the athletes took their marks on the marble starting blocks, and picture the temples, the treasures, the statues as they were.

Day 6 :- Corfu, Greece

Legendary Corfu is a lush and romantic island, written about by Homer in his famous Odyssey. The island's history is full of battles, and Corfu's turbulent position that lasted until modern times with unification with modern Greece in 1864. Corfu offers a combination of old-time-honored Greece. As well as a flower-strewn countryside and Adriatic-style villages, Corfu has splendid coastal scenery and some secluded beaches.

Day 7 :- Kotor, Montenegro

Kotor is a coastal town in Montenegro, located in a most secluded part of the Gulf of Kotor. The old port, surrounded by an impressive wall built by the House of Nemanjic, is very well preserved and is a UNESCO World Heritage site. Numerous other attractions include the Cathedral of St. Tryphon in the old town (built in 1166), and ancient walls which stretch directly above the city. Nightlife also attracts tourists to Kotor with its taverns, cafes, and nightclubs.

Day 8 :- Split, Croatia

Split is the largest Croatian city on the Adriatic coast. Split achieved fame when the Roman emperor Diocletian, noted for his persecution of Christians, had his retirement palace built here. The spectacular stone edifice and its grounds and cellars are a major highlight of the city. Other points of interest include the Cathedral of St. Dujice, built on the remains of an ancient shrine purported to be the oldest in the world, and the Mestrovic Gallery, where the impressive works of Croatian sculptor Ivan Mestrovic are available for viewing in this home and atelier.

Day 9 :- Zadar, Croatia

Found on the northern Dalmatian coast of Croatia, Zadar is rich with thousands of years of history. Ruled at various times by the Romans, Ostrogoths, and Byzantium, the city became a center of commerce and naval power rivaling that of Venice. Today, Zadar's history, architecture draw visitors from around the world, as does Plitvice National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Day 10 :- Trieste, Italy

Located in northeastern Italy, Trieste's geographic location and storied past contributed to its modern standing as one of the country's premier shopper's paradise, Trieste is full of designer boutiques catering to both men and women in search of the latest clothing fashion.
