## Day 4 :- Guangzhou - Macau

- The Ruins of St. Paul's Originally the Church of Mater Dei, it was built between 1602 and 1640 by the
  Jesuits
- St. Dominic Church Founded in 1587 by three Spanish Dominican priests who originally came from Acapulco in Mexic
- Sam Kai Vui Kun A historic Chinese temple located in the heart of Macau's old district. Built between 1723 and 1795
- The Londoner Located on the Cotai Strip, it recreates iconic British landmarks, including a replica of the Palace of

Westminster and a 96-meter-tall Elizabeth Tower (Big Ben)

 ◆ The Venetian – An area that includes a dozen multibillion dollar resorts, a private university campus, and the Macau

garrison of the People's Liberation Army
