Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Casablanca

Upon your arrival at Casablanca Mohamed V Airport, you will be warmly welcomed and assisted before being transferred to your hotel. Day 2 :- Casablanca - Marrakech

After breakfast, begin your half-day sightseeing tour of Casablanca, the bustling business capital of Morocco. Explore the exterior of the magnificent Hassan II Mosque, admire the vibrant Mohamed V Square, and visit the United Nations Place and the central market. Enjoy an independent lunch before heading to Marrakech. Arrive by evening, followed by a delicious dinner and an overnight stay at your hotel.

Day 3 :- Marrakech

Spend the entire day exploring Marrakech, the second oldest imperial city, fondly known as the “Pearl of the South.” Discover its rich heritage with visits to the Medersa Ben Youssef, the iconic Koutoubia Mosque, the opulent Bahia Palace, and the serene Menara Gardens. In the afternoon, wander through the lively souks and the maze of charming little streets, leading to the famous Djemaa El Fna square. Here, immerse yourself in the vibrant atmosphere filled with endless entertainment — from storytellers and snake charmers to fire-eaters and street performers. End the day with a delightful dinner and an overnight stay at your hotel.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 4 :- Marrakech - Ait Benhaddou

After breakfast, depart for Ait Ben Haddou, traveling through the scenic Taddert and crossing the breathtaking Tiz-in-Tichka Pass at 2,260 meters. Continue along the tarred road to the historic Kasbah Telouet. Enjoy a leisurely lunch before visiting the famous Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its striking architecture and rich history. Afterward, take a guided tour of this iconic village before checking in at your hotel. End the day with a delicious dinner and an overnight stay.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 5 :- Ait Benhaddou - Agdz - Merzouga

Enjoy breakfast at your accommodation before departing toward Merzouga. Your first stop will be in Agdz, a town whose name means “resting place” and which lies along the ancient caravan route that once connected Marrakech with Timbuktu. Just outside Agdz, admire the striking landscape dominated by Jbel Kissane Mountain rising to the north. Continue your journey to Rissani, a town famous for its large and lively souk (local market), where you can enjoy a leisurely lunch. Arrive in Merzouga by evening, check in at your hotel, and settle in for an overnight stay.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 6 :- Erfoud - Merzouga Desert

After breakfast, depart for Erfoud, a town often used as a base to explore the region’s stunning landscapes and historic kasbahs, earning it the nickname “The Road of a Thousand Kasbahs.” Erfoud is also renowned for its 360-million-year-old fossils, found in abundance throughout the area. Upon arrival, visit the fascinating Macro Fossils Kasbah and Maison de Nomades, a unique artisan shop in southern Morocco offering a wide range of authentic Moroccan products. Immerse yourself in the area’s rich history and culture before continuing your journey. After lunch, continue your journey to the desert, where you’ll have the option to enjoy an exhilarating 4x4 ride (optional and not included). As the sun begins to set, embark on a memorable camel ride across the golden dunes, taking in the breathtaking desert scenery. Afterward, return to your desert camp in Merzouga, where a delightful dinner awaits, followed by an overnight stay under the starlit sky.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 7 :- Merzouga - Tinghir - Dades

Start your day with breakfast at the desert camp before heading toward Dades, passing through several charming and historic towns along the way. One of the highlights is Tinghir, a picturesque town nestled in the heart of the Todra Valley, between the High Atlas and Jebel Saghro mountain ranges. Tinghir is known for its lush and expansive palm grove, its striking cliffside setting, and the ruins of an old palace once belonging to the famous Glaoui family. This former French garrison town offers stunning views and rich history. Enjoy time for photo breaks and a relaxing lunch in Tinghir before continuing to Dades. As you arrive, you’ll be captivated by the dramatic kasbahs and breathtaking scenery. At an altitude of 1,709 meters, Dades offers panoramic views of the majestic snow-capped Atlas Mountains and the picturesque Dades Valley, dotted with small, traditional Berber villages. End the day with dinner and an overnight stay, surrounded by this remarkable landscape.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 8 :- Dades - Ouarzazate

After breakfast, continue your journey to the vibrant city of Ouarzazate, an important trading hub on the historic caravan routes. This city is home to the impressive Kasbah Tifoutoute, a 17th-century fortress built by the powerful Pasha El Glaoui. Strategically located, the kasbah once served as a vital checkpoint on the caravan route from the Sahara to northern Morocco. A visit to this remarkable site offers a fascinating insight into traditional Berber architecture and the region's rich history. In addition to exploring the kasbah, you'll have the chance to take in stunning views of the Draa Valley and the surrounding mountains. End the day with dinner and an overnight stay in Ouarzazate.

Breakfast Dinner

Day 9 :- Ouarzazate - Marrakech

After breakfast, set off early for Marrakech, taking a scenic and less-traveled back road through the majestic mountains. This route offers breathtaking views of the striking orange-red peaks and winds through charming small villages and the ruins of ancient kasbahs, remnants of the old caravanserai era. Along the journey, you'll be immersed in the beauty and history of the Moroccan landscape. Upon arrival in Marrakech, check in to your hotel and settle in for an overnight stay.
