Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrival in Danang - Hue

Upon arrival at Da Nang International Airport, transfer to Hue via the scenic Hai Van Pass. Along the way, enjoy panoramic views of the ocean, clouds, and mountains, and pass by the tranquil fishing village of Lang Co. Arrive in Hue, the former imperial capital of Vietnam, and visit the traditional Incense Making Village. In the evening, enjoy a royal-style Vietnamese dinner before checking in to the hotel for overnight in Hue.

Dinner

Day 2 :- Hue - Danang

After breakfast, begin the day with a visit to Thien Mu Pagoda, one of Hue's most iconic landmarks. Continue to explore the UNESCO-listed Imperial Citadel, built in 1804, including the Flag Tower, Noon Gate, Nine Dynastic Urns, Nine Holy Cannons, Thai Hoa Palace, the Forbidden Purple City, and the Khai Dinh Royal Tomb. After lunch at a local restaurant, return to Da Nang. Visit the Pink Church, enjoy a scenic drive around Son Tra Peninsula, and stop at Linh Ung Pagoda and My Khe Beach. Dinner and overnight in Da Nang.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 3 :- Danang - Bana Hills

Following breakfast, travel to Ba Na Hills and take a cable car ride for a stunning bird's-eye view of the surrounding mountains and forest. Explore the French Village, the suspension bridge, Nui Chua Mountain Peak, Vong Nguyet Villa, and the Sakyamuni Buddha Monument. Visit the iconic Golden Bridge, known for its giant hands holding the walkway. After lunch, return to Da Nang by cable car. In the afternoon, shop at Han Market and visit key city landmarks including Dragon Bridge, Han River Bridge, and Love Bridge. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant and overnight in Da Nang.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 4 :- Danang - Hoi An - My Son - Coconut Village

After breakfast, visit My Son Sanctuary, a UNESCO World Heritage Site featuring ancient Hindu temples from the Champa Kingdom, built between the 7th and 13th centuries. Continue to Cam Thanh Coconut Village for a relaxing basket boat ride through the coconut forest, and experience local activities like coconut leaf crafting. In the afternoon, explore Hoi An Ancient Town on foot, visiting landmarks such as the Japanese Covered Bridge, Tan Ky Ancient House, Hoi Kien Temple, and the local market. Enjoy some free time for shopping before dinner and overnight in Hoi An.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 5 :- Hoi An - Danang - Departure

After breakfast, enjoy free time for last-minute shopping or exploring. Transfer to the airport for your departure flight.
