

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Nairobi

Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, Nairobi, our guide will meet and greet you. You will be hotel. Overnight at Nairobi. No meal arrangement on day of arrival.

Day 2 :- Amboseli National Park

After breakfast, we will head to Amboseli National Park in the comfort of a custom-made 4x4 Landcruiser. Amboseli National Park covers an area of 392sq. km, close to Tanzania's border has an altitude of 1180km. Amboseli NP is famous for its breathtaking views of Mount Kilimanjaro. On clear day, you can capture stunning photos of elephants with snow-capped mountain in the background. About 80 species of mammals and over 400+ species of birds, making Amboseli National Park a bird watching paradise for the birds' enthusiasts. You will arrive in time for lunch at Ol Tukai Lodge. Day 3 :- Lake Nakuru

We will begin our long journey to Lake Nakuru today. We will break for lunch along the way. Lake Nakuru is one of Kenya's most picturesque Rift Valley lakes, at an elevation of 1850km, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Lake Nakuru is best known for its huge flocks of flamingos which often cover the shores of the lake, creating a spectacular pink and white sight. However, the numbers fluctuate with water conditions. Besides flamingos, you can easily spot Pelicans, Cormorants, Kingfishers, Raptors like eagles and vultures.

Day 4 :- Masai Mara National Reserve

Morning game drive at Nakuru National Park. After breakfast, we will hit the road to Masai Mara – wildebeest traverse plains., a part of the larger Mara-Serengeti ecosystem. Masai Mara is a vast scenic expanse of gently rolling African Savannah Plains stretching 1510sq. m and raises 1500m above sea level. The Masai Mara is famed for its rich wildlife and stunning landscapes – the river crossings at the Mara River where animals must cross while facing predators like crocodiles waiting in the river making this most dramatic spectacles and photo opportunities during the Great Animal Migration period. Evening game drive to spot the Big 5 (Lion, Leopard, Cheetah, Africa Elephants and Rhinoceros).

Day 5 :- Masai Mara National Reserve

Losokwan Luxury Tented Camp is located in North Mara in the Lemek Conservancy. The Camp offers an authentic African bush experience. Each tent is furnished with comfortable bed and a lounge area. There is hot shower, flush toilet, 'balcony- like' seating arrangements, bathrobes, luxury linen, a BBQ area, and ample space to relax and look out for wild animals and bird activities, while having your cup of hot coffee/tea. Cultural visit to Masai Village during game drives where you get a chance to mingle with the local tribe and you'll enjoy a bush meal in the open Savannah.

Day 6 :- Departure Nairobi

Last day in Masai Mara National Reserve. Get up early for a morning hour game drive. During the morning hours' game drive you are advised to bring along a light down jacket. Drives are enjoyable by all ages, young and old. Nocturnal animals like lions, hyenas, leopards are mainly active at night. An early morning game drive might catch these animals coming home with its prey. You can choose to experience a hot-air balloon safari at USD540pp inclusive of a champagne breakfast, upon landing (Optional). We will leave for Nairobi City tour after breakfast. The visit to Karen Blixen Museum/Kenya National Archives and the craft center Utamadani for your last minute's souvenir shopping.
