# Day 1:- Bucharest

### Day 2 :- Bucharest

## Day 3 :- Bucharest - Sinaia - Brasov

# Day 4:- Brasov

# Day 5 :- Brasov - Sighi?oara - Cincsor - Sibiu

Stroll its cobbled lanes and explore the old town on foot, seeing the covered wooden stairs, the landmark clock tower and the house where Vlad the Impaler was supposedly born. See the Gothic Cathedral of St. Mary, known for its ornate interior and the resting place of a Wallachian prince. # Day 6 :- Sibiu - Hunedoara - Timisoara

This morning, you may choose to join an Optional Experience to Muzeul Astra, one of Europe's largest open-air museums, showcasing over 300 original buildings that reflect Romania's rural architecture, crafts and farming heritage. Later, visit Corvin Castle, a spectacular Gothic fortress known for its towers, turrets and tales of Vlad the Impaler. Continue west towards Timi?oara, a city celebrated for its grand architecture and cultural heart. Often called 'Little Vienna', Timi?oara is known for its public squares, Art Nouveau architecture and its key role in the 1989 revolution that shaped modern Romania.

## Day 7:- Timisoara - Budapest

Wake up in Timi?oara, this morning, explore Union Square, framed by elegant Baroque architecture, a striking plague column, and two cathedrals—one Catholic, the other Serbian Orthodox. Soak up the atmosphere in Victory Square, the heart of the city, where a coffee at a bustling cafe is the perfect way to take it all in. This afternoon, cross into Hungary, arriving in Budapest by evening. For a magical end to the day, why not join an optional Danube dinner cruise, gliding past the beauty of the 'Paris of the East'?
