Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Tashkent

Upon arrival at Tashkent Airport, meet at the airport and transfer to the hotel for check in. Overnight in Tashkent.

Day 2 :- Tashkent – Khiva (by flight)

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport for your flight to Khiva. Upon arrival at Urgench Airport, meet your guide and transfer to Khiva for a city tour. Explore Ichan-Kala, the ancient walled inner city, and visit key landmarks such as Kunya-Arc, Pahlavan Mahmud Mausoleum, and Tash-Khovli Palace, each reflecting Khiva's rich architectural and historical legacy. See the iconic Kalta-Minor Minaret, originally intended to be the tallest in the world. Continue with an excursion to the city's mosques and madrasahs, including Jumma Mosque, Muhammad Amin Khan Madrasa, and more. Conclude the day with a transfer to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Breakfast

Day 3 :- Khiva – Bukhara

After breakfast, depart for Bukhara, traveling through the expansive Kyzylkum Desert, which stretches between the Amu Darya and Syr Darya rivers. Known for its striking red sand dunes, rocky formations, and occasional oases, the desert offers a glimpse into Uzbekistan's rugged natural beauty. Arrive in Bukhara and check in at the hotel for an overnight stay.

Breakfast

Day 4 :- Bukhara

After breakfast, explore Bukhara's historical gems, including the Samanid Mausoleum, Chashma-Ayub well, and the ancient Ark Fortress. Visit the elegant Bolo-Hauz Complex, the towering Kalon Minaret, and the mysterious Magoki-Attori Mosque. Stroll through Labi-Hauz, a lively square with tea houses and the statue of Khodja Nasreddin. End the day with a vibrant Folklore Show at Nadir Divan-Begi Madrasa. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Breakfast

Day 5 :- Bukhara – Samarkand (by train)

After breakfast, continue exploring Bukhara with visits to the Sitorai Mohi-Khosa Palace, a stunning blend of Eastern and Western architecture, and the Naqshbandi Memorial Complex, a revered Sufi pilgrimage site known as the "Mecca of Central Asia." Discover the unique Chor Minor Madrasa, famous for its four distinctive minarets. Later, transfer to the train station for departure to Samarkand. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Breakfast

Day 6 :- Samarkand – Tashkent (by train)

After breakfast at the hotel, embark on a city tour of Samarkand, visiting the Ulugbek Observatory, Shahi-Zinda Complex, Bibi-Khanym Mosque, and the iconic Registan Square, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore the bustling Siab Bazaar, known for its fresh produce and local delicacies, before admiring the exquisite Gur Emir Mausoleum, the final resting place of Timur. Later, transfer to the train station for departure to Tashkent, followed by arrival and hotel check-in.

Breakfast

Day 7 :- Tashkent City Tour

After breakfast at the hotel, explore the Hast-Imam Complex, home to the famous Ottoman Quran, along with the Kukeldash Madrasah and the Romanov Residence. Continue the tour in modern Tashkent, visiting Independence Square, the Amir Timur Statue, and Navruz Park. Transfer to the hotel and overnight stay.

Breakfast

Day 8 :- Tashkent

After breakfast at the hotel, visit the Chimgan Mountains and Amirsoi Mountain Resort, known as "Uzbek Switzerland" for its stunning alpine landscapes, fresh air, and diverse wildlife. Explore the Charvak Reservoir, a picturesque mountain lake formed in 1970, rich in history and a key source of clean energy for the region. Transfer to the hotel and overnight stay.

Breakfast

Day 9 :- Tashkent – Margilan – Fergana

After breakfast at the hotel, depart to Margilan; one of the oldest city in the Fergana Valley & famous for "Yodgorlik" silk weaving factory. Visit The Said Ahmad-Khodja Madrasa. Back to Fergana, visit "calling card," is the monument dedicated to the medieval scientist and astronomer Al- Fergani & end with The Babur Mosque. Transfer back to the hotel and overnight stay.

Breakfast

Day 10 :- Fergana – Tashkent

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the Rishtan village and visit the local ceramic's masters. The village is known for its richly decorated pottery, where the dominant color is blue. Continue with excursion in Kokand and visit the castle of the Hudayar Khan whom dedicated all his wealth and energy to decorating his city with numerous elegant mosques, madrasas, and his vast palace, which boasts 113 richly decorated rooms, 19 of which are currently open to the public as a museum. Transfer back to Tashkent and overnight stay.

Breakfast

Day 11 :- Depart Tashkent

After breakfast at the hotel, check out by 12:00 PM. Transfer to the airport for your departure home, taking with you sweet memories of your journey.
