Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrival Hobart

Arrive at Hobart Airport and collect your rental car. Drive approximately 20 minutes to the city centre and settle into your accommodation. Exploring Salamanca Place, the historic Battery Point, and (if time allows) take a scenic drive up to Mount Wellington for panoramic views. Optional to visiting the MONA (Museum of Old and New Art) if you're interested in a contemporary cultural experience. Overnight in Hobart

Day 2 :- Hobart - Port Arthur

Check-out and depart early for a drive to the Port Arthur Historic Site, one of Australia's most significant convict sites. Spend a few hours exploring the ruins, visitor centre, and taking a short harbor cruise. En route, stop by the Tessellated Pavement, Tasman Arch, and Devil's Kitchen. In the afternoon, drive north along the scenic Great Eastern Drive to Bicheno and join the Bicheno Penguin Tour to see little penguins return from the sea. Overnight in Bicheno.

Day 3 :- Bicheno - Freycinet National Park - Launceston

Check-out and drive to Freycinet National Park in the morning and hike to the Wineglass Bay Lookout (1.5–2 hr return). Alternatively, visit Cape Tourville Lookout or Friendly Beaches. Continue drive inland to Launceston through the scenic countryside. Upon arrival, optional to visit Cataract Gorge Reserve, known for its suspension bridge, peacocks, and the world's longest single-span chairlift. Overnight in Launceston.

Day 4 :- Launceston - Cradle Mountain National Park

Check out and leave Launceston early, drive to Cradle Mountain–Lake St Clair National Park. On arrival, park at the visitor centre and use the shuttle service to reach Dove Lake. Enjoy the Dove Lake Circuit (6 km, 2–3 hrs, flat loop with amazing scenery) or take a shorter trail like the Enchanted Walk. Return to Launceston, optionally stopping at Ashgrove Cheese Farm or House of Anvers Chocolate Factory. Overnight in Launceston.

Day 5 :- Launceston - Derwent Bridge - Hobart

Check out and begin the journey back to Hobart. Around halfway, stop at Derwent Bridge to visit The Wall in the Wilderness, a breathtaking 100m-long wood-carved artwork. Continue via the Central Highlands, enjoying lake views and small towns like Tarraleah. Arrive in Hobart in the late afternoon and free at your own leisure. Overnight in Hobart.

Day 6 :- Hobart Departure

Enjoy a relaxing final morning in Hobart and check-out. If time permits, visit the Royal Tasmanian Botanical Gardens or stop by Farm Gate Market (Sundays only) for Tasmanian produce. Return your rental car at the airport before boarding your domestic flight to the next destination.
