Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrival Kansai Airport

Upon arrival at the Kansai International Airport, meet the driver and transfer to the hotel for check-in.

Day 2 :- Osaka

Make your own way to the designated meeting point and begin your seat-in-coach tour with a quick stop at **Osaka Castle**, a historic landmark symbolizing the city's rich heritage. Enjoy a 30-minute stroll through the **Nishinomaru Garden**, known for its seasonal beauty and views of the castle. Continue to **Shitennoji Temple**, one of Japan's oldest Buddhist temples, offering a glimpse into ancient spiritual traditions. Then, explore the lively **Shinsekai and Tsutenkaku area**, a nostalgic district filled with retro charm, neon lights, and local street food.

The tour ends at **Dotonbori Shopping Arcade, where you can enjoy free time before returning to your hotel at your own pace.*

Day 3 :- Osaka

Pick up at hotel, choose ONE of the Seat-In coach tour below.

1. Begin your Kyoto day tour with a visit to the famous **Kinkakuji Temple**, also known as the Golden Pavilion (entrance not included), admired for its stunning gold-leaf exterior and serene garden setting. Continue to the **Heian Shrine**, a grand Shinto shrine known for its striking torii gate and beautifully landscaped grounds. Next, explore **Kiyomizu Temple** (entrance not included), a UNESCO World Heritage Site perched on a hillside with panoramic city views. Afterwards, enjoy shopping and sightseeing along the charming historical streets of **Shimizuzaka, San'nei Zaka, and Ninen Zaka**, lined with traditional wooden shops and tea houses. The tour concludes with a transfer back to your hotel.
2. Embark on a Kyoto and Nara day tour starting with a visit to **Kinkakuji Temple**, the iconic Golden Pavilion (entrance not included), renowned for its striking architecture and reflective pond setting. Continue to the grand **Heian Shrine**, famous for its massive torii gate and elegant gardens. In Nara, explore the impressive **Todaiji Temple**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site housing one of the world's largest bronze Buddha statues. Conclude the tour with a stroll through **Nara Deer Park**, where you'll encounter hundreds of friendly, freely roaming deer in a serene natural setting.
