Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Auckland

Upon arrival in Auckland, you will be met and privately transferred to your accommodation. Auckland is New Zealand's largest city, home to sheltered, sparkling blue waters dotted with beautiful emerald islands. Overnight: Auckland.

Optional Activities: Sky Tower, Weta Workshop Unleashed, All Blacks New Zealand Experience, Auckland Harbour Dinner Cruise

Day 2 :- Auckland - Waitomo - Hobbiton - Rotorua

Depart Auckland through the stunning Waikato countryside to Waitomo Caves for a guided tour of the many different cave formations. Descend further underground for a cruise on the grotto river with thousands of glowworms glittering above your head. At Hobbiton Movie Set you'll see sights like Hobbit Holes, the Mill and the Green Dragon Inn on your guided walking tour. Continue to the geothermal wonderland of Rotorua for a magical, illuminated forest walk on the elevated boardwalks amongst the giant redwood trees. Overnight: Rotorua.

Day 3 :- Rotorua

Rotorua is surrounded by a fascinating geothermal landscape with its unique steam vents, spouting geysers and bubbling mud pools. Visit Wai-O-Tapu for a self-guided walk through the region's most colourful park followed by a tour of Rotorua highlights. This might include Lake Rotorua, and Government Gardens watching the white-water rafting at Okere Falls. This afternoon, visit Te Puia for a guided tour of the Maori Arts & Crafts Institute, Kiwi Conservation Centre, geothermal valley and geyser. End the day with an Evening Cultural Performance with traditional songs, haka and Buffet Dinner. Overnight: Rotorua.

Day 4 :- Rotorua - Christchurch (Flight Not Included)

Transfer for to Rotorua Airport. On arrival in Christchurch, collect your rental vehicle or be transferred to your accommodation. Christchurch is set between the deep blue Pacific Ocean and the mighty snow-capped Southern Alps. This is a vibrant, ever-changing city with inner city parks and gardens delightfully interwoven by the meandering Avon River. Overnight: Christchurch.

Optional Activities: Christchurch Tram Dinner, International Antarctic Centre

Day 5 :- Christchurch - Glacier Region

Travel from civilisation and cultivation on the East Coast to the raw untouched wilderness of the West Coast. Wander among the striking limestone rock formations at Castle Hill and witness the majestic Southern Alps up close. At Arthur's Pass Village you can choose to hike the Devil's Punchbowl track to view the spectacular waterfall. Discover the breathtaking Hokitika Gorge, a hidden gem renowned for its mesmerizing turquoise waters. Overnight: Glacier Region.

Day 6 :- Glacier Region - Queenstown

Make a visit to picture perfect Lake Matheson where a snow-capped Mt Cook is elegantly reflected across the mirror lake on a calm day. Discover the best of the West Coast where thick native rainforest meets the expansive ocean. Take a short walk to the spectacular Thunder Creek Falls and the Blue Pools (when open). View stunning Lake Hawea and picturesque Wanaka with #ThatWanakaTree before arriving in Queenstown. Overnight: Queenstown.

Day 7 :- Queenstown

Magnificent vistas and majestic mountains dominate this compact alpine resort town. Soak up the scenic sights and visit Queenstown's "must see" locations with a birds eye view over Lake Wakatipu, the Remarkables and Lord of the Rings locations. Visit Kawarau Bridge and discover the thrill of bungy as you watch intrepid jumpers from the viewing deck. Stop in the Gibbston Wine Region and explore the gold rush history and picturesque colonial architecture in Arrowtown. Overnight: Queenstown.

Day 8 :- Queenstown - Milford Sound - Queenstown

Fiordland is one of the world's last great wildernesses. Today's stunning tour takes you past mirror lakes and waterfalls into Milford Sound, carved by ice age glaciers and famously described as the eighth wonder of the world. On arrival, board your vessel for a cruise of the fiord surrounded by towering mountains and cliffs that plunge into the sea. Remainder of the day is free to add optional experiences (additional cost applies). Overnight: Queenstown.

Day 10 :- Queenstown - Mt Cook Region

Pass through the stunning Kawarau Gorge and fruit and wine growing region of Cromwell. Stop at Jacksons Orchard to try or buy some delicious local fruit or real fruit ice cream (self-drive or private touring only). Follow beautiful Lake Dunstan and be dwarfed by the vast and dramatic Lindis Pass on the journey past lakes too blue to be true to a rugged and magnificent land of rock and ice. Overnight Mt Cook Region.

Optional Activities: Hooker Valley Walk, Ultimate Alpine Experience Ski Plane/Helicopter Combo

Day 11 :- Mt Cook Region - Christchurch

Traverse the vast plains of the Mackenzie district alongside the magnificent turquoise blue lake framed by Aoraki Mt Cook. Make a stop at the popular Church of the Good Shepherd before the green patchwork farms that signal your return into Christchurch. Overnight: Christchurch.

Day 12 :- Christchurch Departure

Arrangements conclude today with the return of your rental car or departure transfer to Christchurch Airport.
