

Tour Itinerary**Day 1 :- Arrive Almaty**

Upon arrival, meet and greet at the airport. Transfer to hotel for check in. Overnight in Almaty.

Day 2 :- Almaty

Breakfast at hotel, followed by a panoramic city tour. Visit Park of the 28 Panfilov Guardsmen, Zenkov Cathedral, and the War Memorial. Explore Republic Square and the Independence Monument. Enjoy an excursion to Kok Tobe Hill, with stunning city views and a cable car ride. Transfer to the hotel for an overnight stay in Almaty.

Breakfast

Day 3 :- Medeo - Shymbulak & Falcon Show

Enjoy an excursion to Medeo-Shymbulak, visiting the Medeo Skating Rink, one of the world's highest ice rinks, and Shymbulak Ski Resort, known for skiing, hiking, and breathtaking mountain views. Watch a falconry show at the Sunkar Falcon Nursery, dedicated to breeding and preserving rare birds of prey. Transfer to the hotel for an overnight stay in Almaty.

Breakfast

Day 4 :- Charyn Canyon & Kolsay Lake

After breakfast, transfer to Charyn Canyon (3hrs), known for its stunning rock formations and deep gorges. Continue to Saty Village (2hrs) to visit the lowest Kolsay Lake, surrounded by alpine scenery and dense spruce forests. Return to the city and overnight in Almaty.

Breakfast

Day 5 :- Almaty (Kazakhstan) - Bishkek (Kyrgyzstan)

After breakfast, depart for Bishkek (4hrs). Upon arrival, meet your tour guide and transfer to the hotel for check-in, followed by leisure time to relax. Overnight in Bishkek.

Breakfast

Day 6 :- Bishkek City Tour

After breakfast, depart for Bishkek City Tour. Explore the city with visits to Kyrgyz National University, the Philharmonic Hall, Manas Statue, Victory Square, Oak Park, and Ala-Too Square. Experience the vibrant atmosphere of Osh Bazaar before returning to the hotel for an overnight stay in Bishkek.

Breakfast

Day 7 :- Ala-Archa & Alamedin Gorge Tour

After breakfast, visit Ala-Archa National Park, a stunning nature reserve known for its diverse landscapes, rare wildlife, and breathtaking mountain views. Continue to Alamedin Gorge, famous for its alpine meadows, waterfalls, and natural hot springs. Return to the city for an overnight stay in Bishkek.

Breakfast

Day 8 :- Konorchek Canyon - Balasugun Tour

After breakfast, embark on an excursion to the Konorchek Canyons, known for their striking red sandstone formations and an ancient extinct volcano. Then, visit the historic Burana Tower, a remnant of the 9th-century Karakhanid Empire and a key stop on the Silk Road. Return to the city for an overnight stay in Bishkek.

Breakfast

Day 9 :- Chungurchak - Supara Etno Complex

After breakfast, visit Chungurchak Gorge, a scenic destination at 2,400 meters, known for its pine forests, waterfalls, and rare royal tulips. Explore the Supara Ethno Complex and enjoy traditional Kyrgyz cuisine, horse riding, and archery. Back to the city and overnight in Bishkek.

Breakfast

Day 10 :- Bishkek (Kyrgyzstan) - Dushanbe (Tajikistan)

Breakfast at hotel and check out. Transfer to airport for departure to Dushanbe. Upon arrival at Dushanbe International Airport, transfer to the hotel for check-in and a short rest. In the evening, explore Dushanbe with visits to Rudaki Park, the Samani Monument, the Flagpole, and the Istiklol architectural complex, finishing with a stop at the local bazaar. Overnight in Dushanbe.

Breakfast

Day 11 :- Dushanbe

After breakfast, drive to Hissar (30 km from Dushanbe) to visit the 17th-century Hissar Fortress, Kukhna Madrasah, and ancient caravanserais. Return to Dushanbe for visits to the Kokhi Navruz complex and the National Museum, ending the day at the local bazaar. Back to the hotel and overnight in Dushanbe.

Breakfast

Day 12 :- Dushanbe

After breakfast, depart early for Iskanderkul, a high-mountain lake in the Fann Mountains (about 3 hours), with stops at scenic passes along the way. Upon arrival, enjoy a walk around the lake, a short hike to the Fann Niagara waterfall, and an optional boat ride. After lunch by the lake, return to Dushanbe for an overnight stay. Back to hotel and overnight in Dushanbe.

Breakfast

Day 13 :- Dushanbe (Tajikistan) - Ashgabat (Turkmenistan)

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Turkmenistan. Upon arrival in Ashgabat, meet your guide and transfer to the hotel before driving to the ancient Nissa Fortress, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and then to the Turkmenbashy Ruhy Mosque in Kipchak. Continue with an Ashgabat city tour, including the Wedding Palace, Yildyz Hotel, Ferris Wheel, Constitution Monument, Arch of Neutrality, Independence Park, Ertogrol Gazy Mosque, the Olympic Stadium, and the Halk Hakydasý Memorial Complex. Overnight in Ashgabat.

Breakfast

Day 14 :- Ashgabat - Derweze

After breakfast, visit either the Altyn Asyr Oriental Bazaar; one of the world's largest open markets or the historic Gulistan Bazaar. In the afternoon, drive to the Darwaza Gas Crater, known as the "Door to Hell," created in 1971 when a natural gas cavern collapsed and was set alight to prevent toxic emissions. Enjoy the dramatic evening view of the burning crater, followed by a BBQ dinner and an overnight stay in a yurt camp.

Breakfast

Day 15 :- Ashgabat

After a picnic-style breakfast, back to Ashgabat and check in to the hotel. After lunch, visit the Gokdepe Fortress, the Geokdepe Mosque and Gokdepe Museum. Continue to a horse farm to see the famed Akhalteke horses, a pure and ancient Turkmen breed. On the return to Ashgabat, stop at the Turkmenbashi Ruhi Mosque and mausoleum. Overnight in Ashgabat.

Breakfast

Day 16 :- Ashgabat (Turkmenistan) - Tashkent (Uzbekistan)

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Tashkent. Upon arrival, meet your guide and begin a city tour of the old town, visiting the Hast-Imam Complex, Kukeldash Madrasah, and the Romanov Palace. Continue through modern Tashkent with stops at Independence Square, the Amir Temur statue, and Navruz Park. Transfer to the hotel for check in and overnight in Tashkent.

Breakfast

Day 17 :- Tashkent - Samarkand - Tashkent

After breakfast, transfer to the train station for departure to Samarkand. Upon arrival, enjoy a city tour with visits to Registan Square, the bustling Siab Bazaar, and the Gur Emir Mausoleum. Later, return by train to Tashkent and back to hotel.

Day 18 :- Depart Tashkent

After breakfast, followed by check-out by 12:00 PM. Transfer to the airport for departure, taking home sweet memories of the trip.
