Day 1 :- St. Petersburg

Arrival in St. Petersburg. Meeting with guide. Transfer to the hotel & Check in. Overnight in St. Petersburg.

Guide and transport 4 hrs

Day 2 :- St. Petersburg

Breakfast at the hotel & Meeting with guide. 10:00-15:00 Sightseeing tour of Saint Petersburg. During this City Tour you will visit Nevsky Prospekt, the main street of St. Petersburg, the magnificent ensembles of the city, such as the Palace Square with the Hermitage and the Square of Arts, St Isaac's Square, the Admiralty, admire the most beautiful cathedrals and churches of the city, including the Church of the Resurrection (also called the Church on Spilled Blood) Kazan Cathedral. You will see the most beautiful palaces and monuments of the city, such as the Winter Palace, the Mariinsky Palace and Michael Castle, the Bronze Horseman and the monument to Catherine the Great. St. Isaacs cathedral. Peter and Paul Fortress.

Day 3 :- St. Petersburg

Breakfast at the hotel & Meeting with guide. Visit Hermitage Museum The museum is located in the former Winter Palace, residence of the Tsars. The Hermitage is the largest museum in Russia and one of the largest in the world, with more than 3 million works of art. It has collections of sculpture and painting, glass and porcelain, tapestries and jewelry, prints, antiquities from the classical period, weapons, medals, coins, precious books. You will find a great collection of paintings from the Italian, Flemish, French and Spanish schools. Overnight in St. Petersburg

Day 4 :- St. Petersburg

After proceed to Peterhof. Park and Palace. Peterhof, also called the "Russian Versailles" was the main summer residence of the Tsars. Located on the southern coast of the Gulf of Finland, about 25 km from the city of St. Petersburg, is one of the main attractions in the old imperial capital. It is a vast complex including the Grand Palace and the park, several smaller palaces and pavilions scattered in the beautiful gardens. You can find 150 fountains and three waterfalls, the colorful "water games" and golden statues of incomparable beauty. Overnight in St. Petersburg.

Guide and transport 6 hrs

Day 5 :- St. Petersburg - Novgorod The Great (190 KM) - St. Petersburg

Breakfast. Early morning. Day tour in Novgorod- one of the most ancient cities of Russia. We will visit St Sophia Cathedral in the territory of Kremlin, you will see the Monument to the Millenium of Russia, Yaroslav's Court and Ancient Torg, St. George Cathedral (12 century) in the territory of Yuriev Monastery. We also will visit Vitoslavitsy- open- air museum of wooden architecture. The way back to St Petersburg. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 6 :- St. Petersburg - Moscow

Breakfast. Check out. Transfer to the railway station to take speedy train Sapsan (aprox 4h). Way to Moscow. On the evening arrival to Moscow. Transfer to the hotel. Check in. Overnight in Moscow

Day 7 :- Moscow

Breakfast at the hotel & Meeting with guide. During the Sightseeing tour by Moscow city you will see the Red Square – is often considered the central square of Moscow and all of Russia. The walk on the Red Square will be followed by Saint Basil's Cathedral (outside), which was ordered by Ivan the Terrible to mark the 1552 capture of Kazan from Mongol forces. Also you will appreciate the GUM- Moscow's "State Department Store", takes up almost the entire eastern side of Red Square. Zaryadye park. The River Overlook — 70-metres long concrete console, offers panoramic views of the Kremlin, the city center, the river embankment, and the park itself. Overnight in Moscow

Day 8 :- Moscow

Breakfast at the hotel and Meeting with guide

You will visit Sparrow hills. The height of viewpoint is 80 meters and there you can see a stunning view of Moscow city. On the top of the Sparrow hills there are Moscow State University building complex. After that you will visit The Cathedral of Christ the Saviour. It's may be the largest Orthodox Church in the world. The building is magnificent, but not as old as it looks: it was rebuilt in 2000 after Stalin demolished the original. After we proceed to Metro tour. The Moscow Metro has 271 stations and traces its history back to 1935. Each station is a separate world created by engineers, architects, sculptors, and artists. Let's slow down on this tour and take a look at the oldest and most beautiful metro stations. Visit Arbat Street It is one of the oldest streets in Moscow. Its name comes from the word "Arbad" or "rabad" which means "suburb". In the years 1974 – 1986 Arbat became Pedestrian Street with many shops, cafes, shopping areas, restaurants, street vendors and so on. Today Arbat Street retains its own unique Moscow look of past centuries. Overnight in Moscow.

Breakfast at the hotel and Meeting with guide Visit Kremlin Territory and Cathedral. The Moscow Kremlin is a stone chronicle of Russia. As in antiquity, today history is made here. The architectural ensemble of the Moscow Kremlin includes monuments of different centuries. Here you will see the palaces of Russian sovereigns, emperors, hierarchs of the Russian Orthodox Church, as well as the residence of the President of Russia. Free time for shopping. Overnight in Moscow.
