Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrive Antananarivo

Welcome to Madagascar! Upon arrival at Ivato International Airport in the capital city, you will clear visa and customs formalities. You will be warmly met and greeted by your English-speaking IndigoBe guide holding a personalized sign. Board your vehicle for a smooth private transfer to your premium hotel. Upon check-in, you will receive a welcome cocktail, the delivery of your comprehensive information pack, and a special welcome gift. The rest of the day is at your absolute leisure to relax, adjust to the local time zone, and enjoy the upscale amenities of the hotel.

Day 2 :- Antananarivo - Soalala - Namoroka

After breakfast, transfer back to the light aircraft private charter area of Ivato Airport to board your scheduled private light aircraft at 09:00 AM. Enjoy a scenic 1-hour and 15-minute flight showcasing bird's-eye views of the remote Malagasy topography before landing at the remote landing strip in Soalala. Your dedicated safari driver-guide will be waiting with a 4x4 safari vehicle to transfer you through untamed landscapes to the tented camp (approximately 2.5 hours). Check in to your luxury safari tent nestled directly inside a pocket of dry deciduous forest bordering Namoroka National Park, followed by lunch at the camp. At around 16:00 PM, embark on a thrilling night walking safari directly from the camp. This easy 2-kilometer circuit (taking 1.5 to 2 hours) offers an incredible introduction to the park's nocturnal universe. Armed with spotlights, you will silently look for active nocturnal primates such as the sportive lemur (*Lepilemur ahmansonii*), the grey mouse lemur (*Microcebus murinus*), and Peters' mouse lemur (*Microcebus myoxinus*). Keep an eye out for the endemic leaf-nosed snake (*Langaha*), which uses cryptic coloration to blend perfectly into the branches.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 3 :- Namoroka

Fuel up with breakfast before departing on a 4x4 safari vehicle for a short 25-minute drive to the Ambozimarohabo circuit. Today's exploration combines hiking through spectacular limestone karst formations (Tsingy), wildlife spotting, and discovering unique desert flora like giant ancient baobabs and spiny pachypodiums. This 5-kilometer loop takes about 3 hours of easy-to-moderate walking and culminates at a magnificent viewpoint overlooking the sprawling, dramatic stone ridges. Along the way, spot diurnal lemur species such as the red-fronted brown lemur (*Eulemur rufus*) and the spectacular Van Der Decken's sifaka (*Propithecus deckenii*) dancing across the rock faces. Afterward, take a 1-hour drive to Mandevy, a stunning natural oasis where clear, underground mountain spring water emerges with power from the limestone aquifers. Enjoy a private lunch shaded by the riverside trees. In the afternoon, explore the easy 3-kilometer Ambatofolaka circuit through low-canopy forests and rich wetlands. Look for rare birdlife, including the Schlegel's Asity (*Philepitta schlegeli*) and the critically endangered Madagascar fish eagle (*Icthyophaga vociferoides*). Return to the camp to wind down before enjoying a special private candlelit dinner under the forest canopy.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 4 :- Namoroka

Following breakfast, embark on a 1-hour drive from the camp to the Ambovononby area, famously known as the Great Tsingy. Your guided morning trek snakes through rugged paths bordered by razor-sharp rocks and twisted, dry-adapted trees. The route brings you to a fascinating underground cave network illuminated by shafts of natural sunlight. Explore the cooler cavern chambers to view incredible subfossils of extinct Malagasy giants, such as pygmy hippopotamuses and giant lemurs that roamed the island before human arrival. Enjoy a picnic lunch nearby. In the afternoon, a short 30-minute drive takes you to Andranovorimena, a crucial roosting sanctuary for hundreds of massive Madagascar fruit bats (*Pteropus rufus*). Witness the dynamic and noisy spectacle of these giant bats hanging in dense clusters from the tree canopy. As darkness approaches, head out on the Ampandrana night circuit. This easy 1.5-kilometer walk follows a permanent humid stream corridor north of the camp, where you can spot the elusive pale fork-marked lemur (*Phaner cf. pallescens*) jumping through the branches, chameleons freezing in position, and tenrecs searching the forest floor.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 5 :- Namoroka

Today begins with an exciting drive to the Antsifotra circuit, an incredible itinerary combining geological exploration, deep canyons, and vast subterranean networks. Trek through narrow, vegetation-covered slot canyons to enter one of the most extensive cave systems in all of Africa. Walk among ancient mineral structures, including massive curtains of stalactites and stalagmites shaped by water over millennia, and view ancient, undated cave paintings left behind by early human populations. Look up to see dense colonies of endemic fruit bats (*Eidolon dupreanum* and *Rousettus madagascariensis*) roosting in the dark inner chambers. Return to the camp for lunch. In the afternoon, take a relaxed walk to the Small Tsingys and Baobab Hill. Stroll to a scenic viewpoint where irregular limestone spires clash beautifully with the dry forest, before walking up a nearby hill to stand among monumental, ancient baobab trees. Take time to appreciate these silent, sacred botanical guardians of the landscape. End your final safari evening with a breathtaking wilderness sunset and a private farewell cocktail.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 6 :- Namoroka - Soalala - Antananarivo - Departure

Enjoy an early breakfast before checking out at 07:00 AM. Take a 2.5-hour overland drive back toward Soalala, where you will cross the local river in traditional Malagasy dugout pirogues to reach the airstrip. Board your private charter small aircraft at 10:30 AM for your flight back to the capital. Arrive at Ivato Airport in Antananarivo around 12:00 PM, where you will be assisted by an English-speaking guide to check in for your international flight back home to Kuala Lumpur. Your exclusive western Madagascar signature safari officially concludes.

Remarks

Strict Luggage Weight Limits: Passengers are permitted a maximum total luggage allowance of only 20kg per person, which must include their soft suitcase, hand luggage, and any photographic equipment. Rigid or hard-shell suitcases are strictly forbidden on light aircraft flights.
