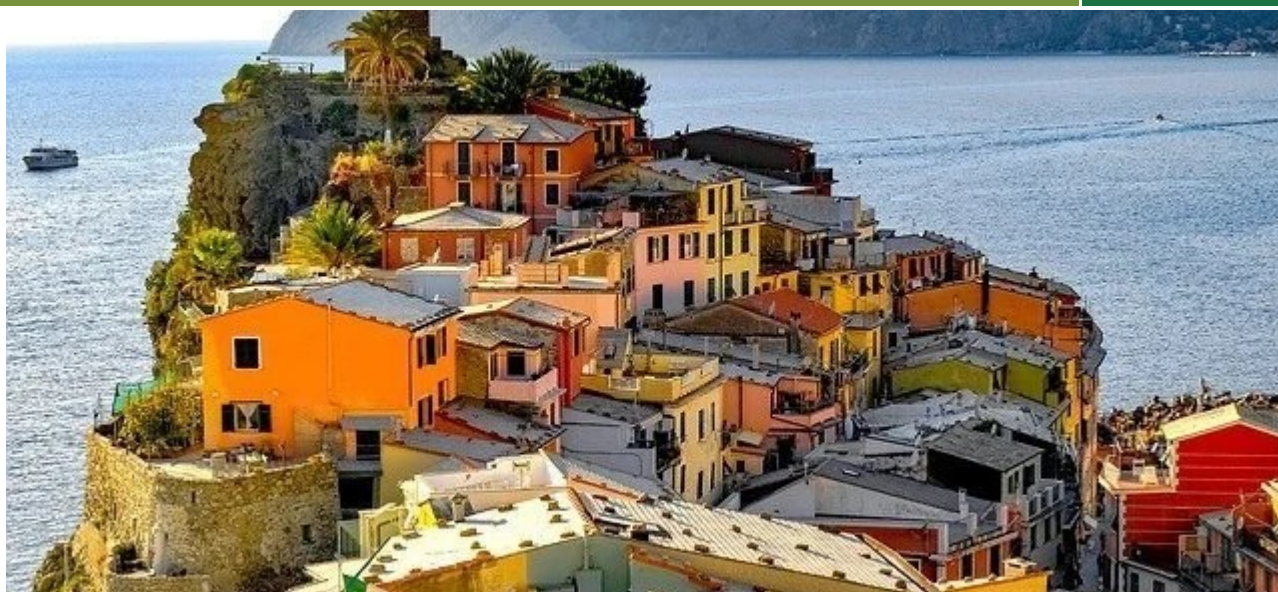

Barcelona, Spain :- Barcelona, Spain
