Tour Itinerary

Day 1 :- Arrival Osaka

Upon arrival at Kansai International Airport, meet your driver and begin your tour with a visit to Kuromon Ichiba Market, known as “Osaka’s Kitchen” and famous for its fresh street food, seafood, and local snacks. Continue to Tsutenkaku Tower, where you can explore the surrounding traditional streets lined with local snack stalls and souvenir shops.

Day 2 :- Historical Wonders of Nara & Kyoto - Osaka

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your tour with a visit to Nara Park, a scenic park famous for its hundreds of freely roaming sacred deer. Continue to Kiyomizu-dera Temple, one of Japan’s most celebrated UNESCO World Heritage Sites, before heading to Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine, renowned for its iconic vermilion torii gates. End the day at Gion and Hanamikoji Street, Kyoto’s historic geisha district, where traditional wooden merchant houses, charming teahouses, and cultural heritage create a timeless atmosphere.

Day 3 :- Osaka Highlights & Bullet Train to Fukuoka (Around 2.5 Hours)

After breakfast at the hotel, check out and begin your tour with a visit to Kizu Wholesale Market, a historic market renowned for its fresh seafood and local produce. Continue to Shinsaibashi Shopping Street, Osaka’s vibrant shopping district featuring a mix of international fashion brands and local boutiques. End the day at Dotonbori Food Street, an iconic dining destination famous for Osaka’s local specialties, lively atmosphere, and dazzling neon lights.

After the sightseeing, drop-off at the Shinkansen (bullet train) station. Board the Shinkansen to Fukuoka. Upon arrival at Fukuoka Station, transfer to the hotel for check-in.

Day 4 :- Heritage & Waterways of Kumamoto

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your tour with a relaxing Yanagawa River Cruise, where you’ll glide through picturesque canals on a traditional boat while taking in the town’s charming scenery. Continue to Kumamoto Castle, one of Japan’s most magnificent historic castles, celebrated for its impressive architecture and rich samurai heritage.

Breakfast Lunch

Day 5 :- Kumamoto - The Majestic Volcanic Landscapes of Aso - Beppu

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your tour with a visit to Kusasenri, a vast grassland offering breathtaking views of Mount Aso’s volcanic landscape. Continue to Shirakawa Suigen, a crystal-clear spring renowned for its pure natural water, before heading to Mount Aso, one of the world’s largest active volcanoes. *Please note that access to the crater or summit is subject to volcanic activity and weather conditions on the day of your visit.* Conclude the day at Kamishikimi Kumanoza Shrine, a mystical forest shrine known for its moss-covered stone lanterns and tranquil atmosphere.

Day 6 :- Fairytale Towns & Scenic Peaks in Beppu

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your tour with a visit to Yufuin Floral Village, a charming fairytale-inspired village filled with unique boutiques, cafés, and themed shops. Continue to Lake Kinrin, a picturesque lake renowned for its serene beauty and enchanting morning mist. Stroll along Yunotsubo Street, a lively shopping street lined with local cafés, specialty stores, and regional delicacies, before taking in the scenic views of Mount Yufu, the iconic twin-peaked mountain that overlooks the charming town of Yufuin.

Day 7 :- Beppu - Hot Spring Curiosities & Panoramic Views - Fukuoka

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your tour with the renowned Beppu Hells Tour (Jigoku Meguri), where you’ll explore a collection of vibrant, steaming hot spring pools shaped by volcanic activity. Continue with a Beppu Jigokumushi (Hell Steaming) experience, a unique local culinary tradition that uses natural geothermal steam to cook fresh vegetables, seafood, and meat, making it a recommended lunch experience. Conclude the day with a scenic ride on the Beppu Ropeway to Mount Tsurumi, offering spectacular panoramic views of Beppu, the coastline, and the surrounding mountains.

Day 8 :- Fukuoka - Coastal Itoshima & Tradiitional Houseboat Dinner

After breakfast at the hotel, travel to Itoshima and begin your tour with a visit to Shiraito Falls, a picturesque waterfall surrounded by lush greenery. Continue to Sakurai Futamigaura, home to the iconic white torii gate standing in the sea against stunning coastal views. Take a relaxing break at Forest Cafe, a cosy café nestled amidst tranquil woodland, before ending the day at Kitazaki Coast, where you can enjoy breathtaking views of the coastline and the sparkling sea.
